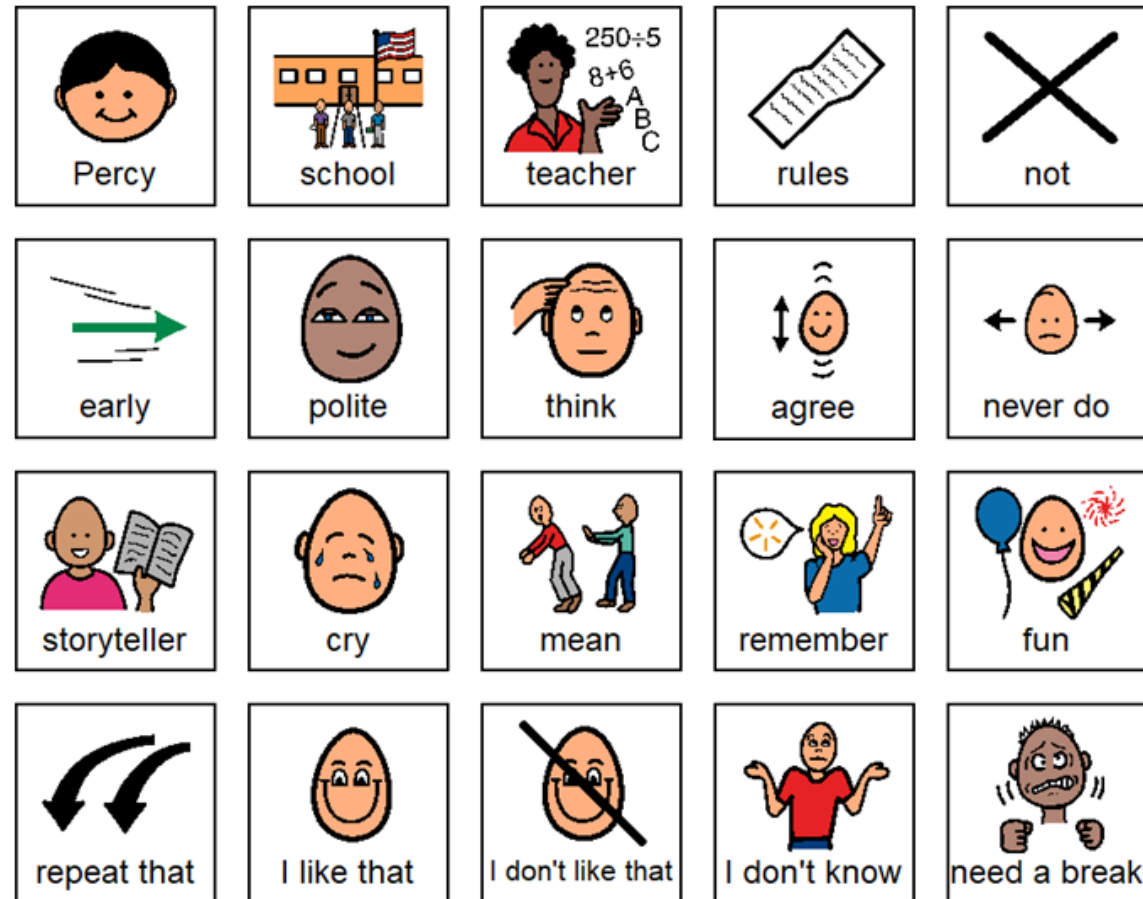
This unit has 5 activities to go with this book to last a full week of instruction.

This unit comes with a storyboard.

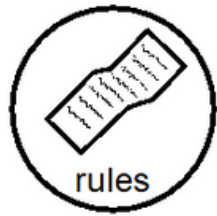
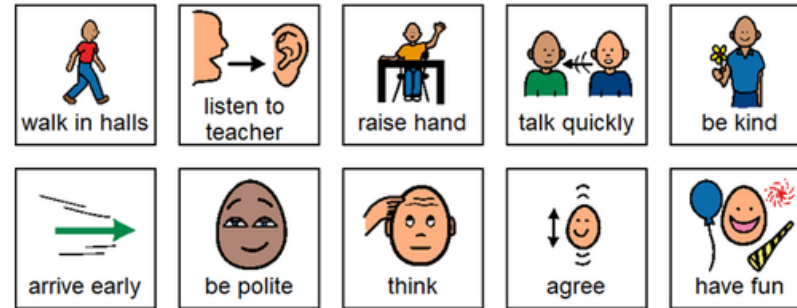
Storyboards are great for ALL students to assist with participation and engagement in group discussions.

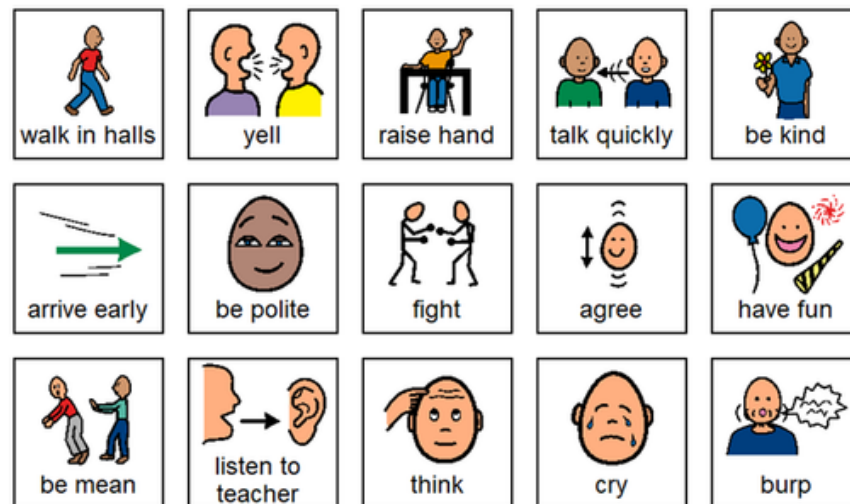


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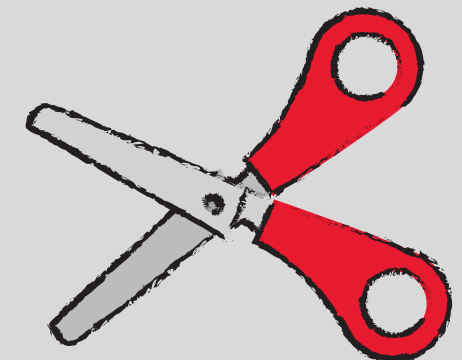
Cut apart pictures and place in circle map about some of the rules Percy talks about in the book.



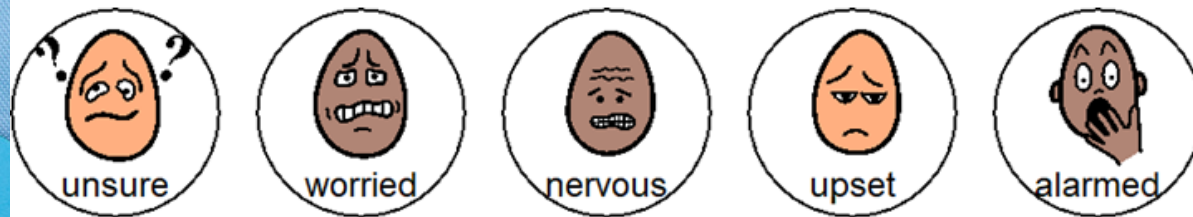
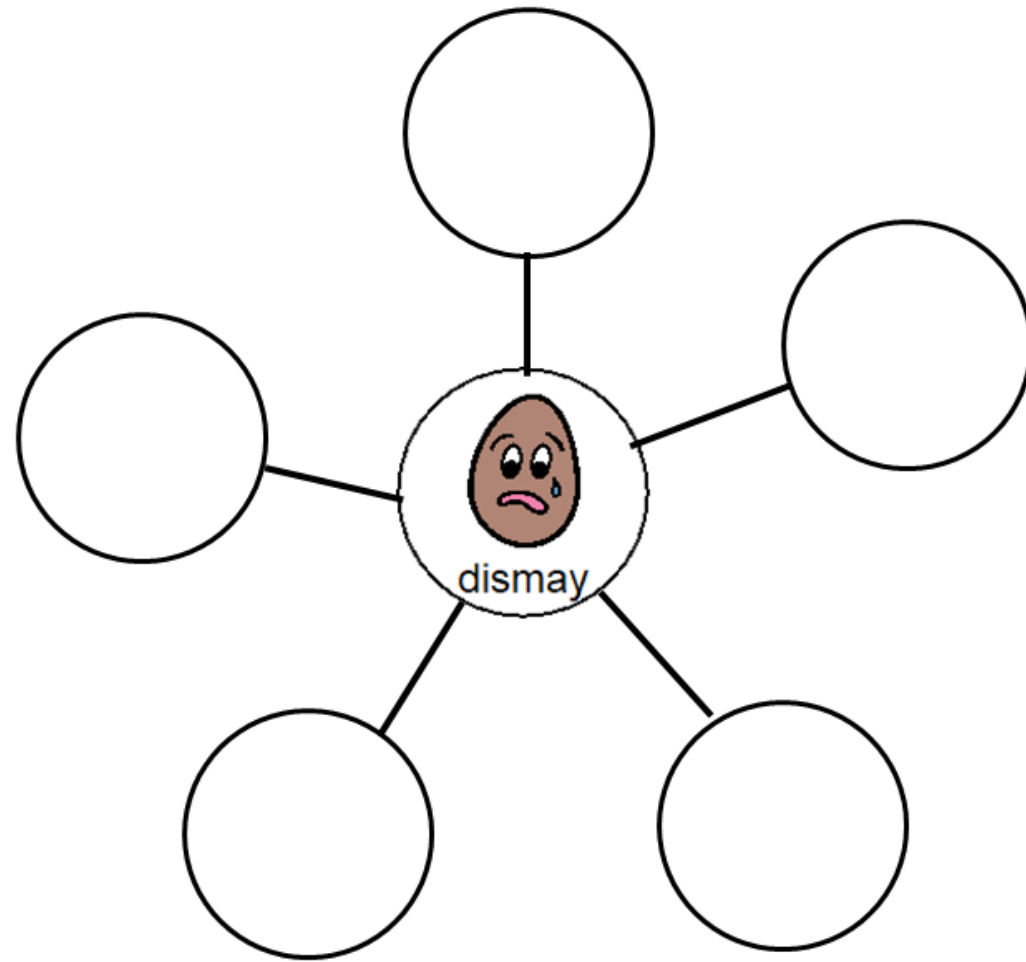
Cut apart pictures and place in circle map **ONLY IF** they are some of the rules Percy talks about in the book.



There is a circle map showing school rules according to Percy. There is an option that only has correct answers and one that has wrong answers mixed in.

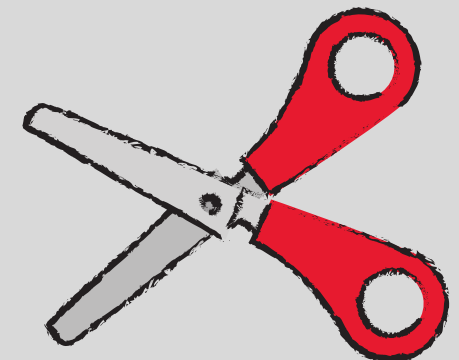


What does dismay mean?

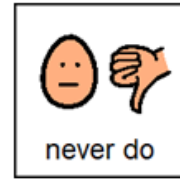
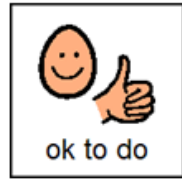






















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Students will complete a word map showing other words for dismay. This is an errorless task.

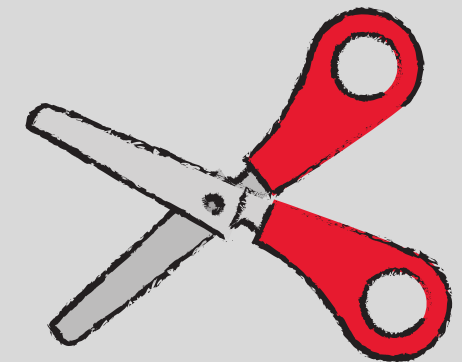

There is a sorting activity. Students will sort things Percy says you can do and things you should NEVER do. There is a suggestion for differentiation included.



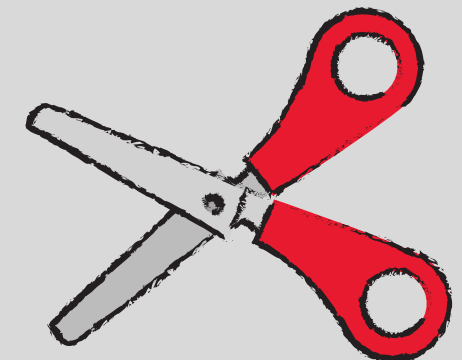

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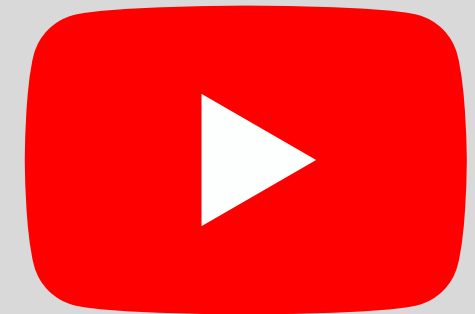
Students will write their own story about having the best year ever. They can pretend they are someone or something else if they would like. This is an errorless activity that allows students to write their own story independently.

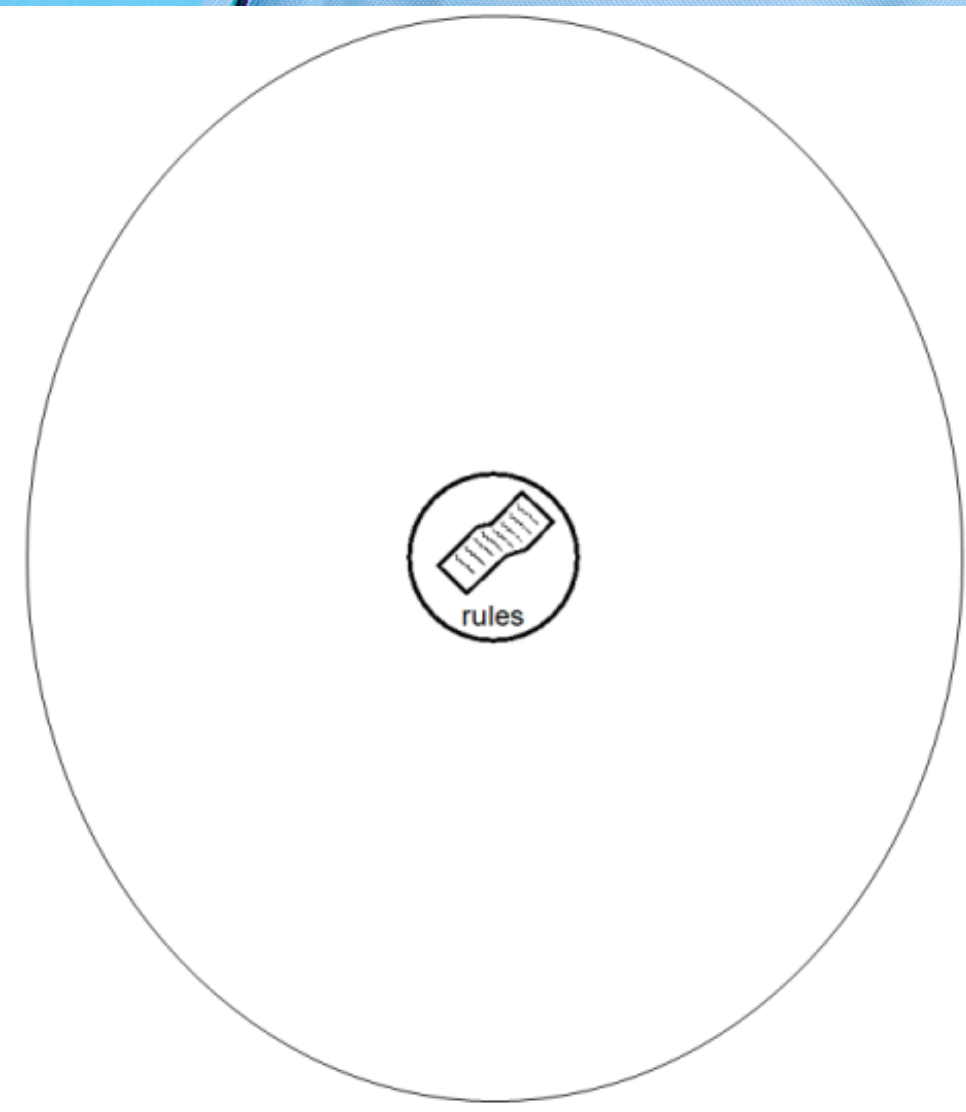

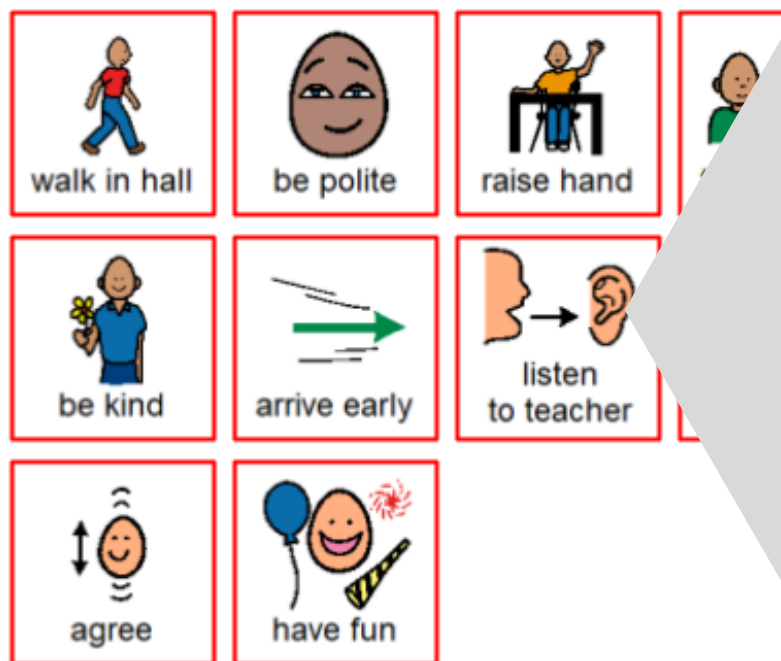


Great for review

There are digital versions of the activities included. Students click and drag the answers.




















Place the pictures in circle map showing some of the rules Percy talks about in the book.




