





During this time, over 17000 people were killed using the Guillotine. Even the queen, Marie Antoinette, suspected of treason, was beheaded.



Napoleon took over France and made himself the new leader. Eventually, he had himself appointed as the emperor of France and began taking over all of the rest of Europe.







