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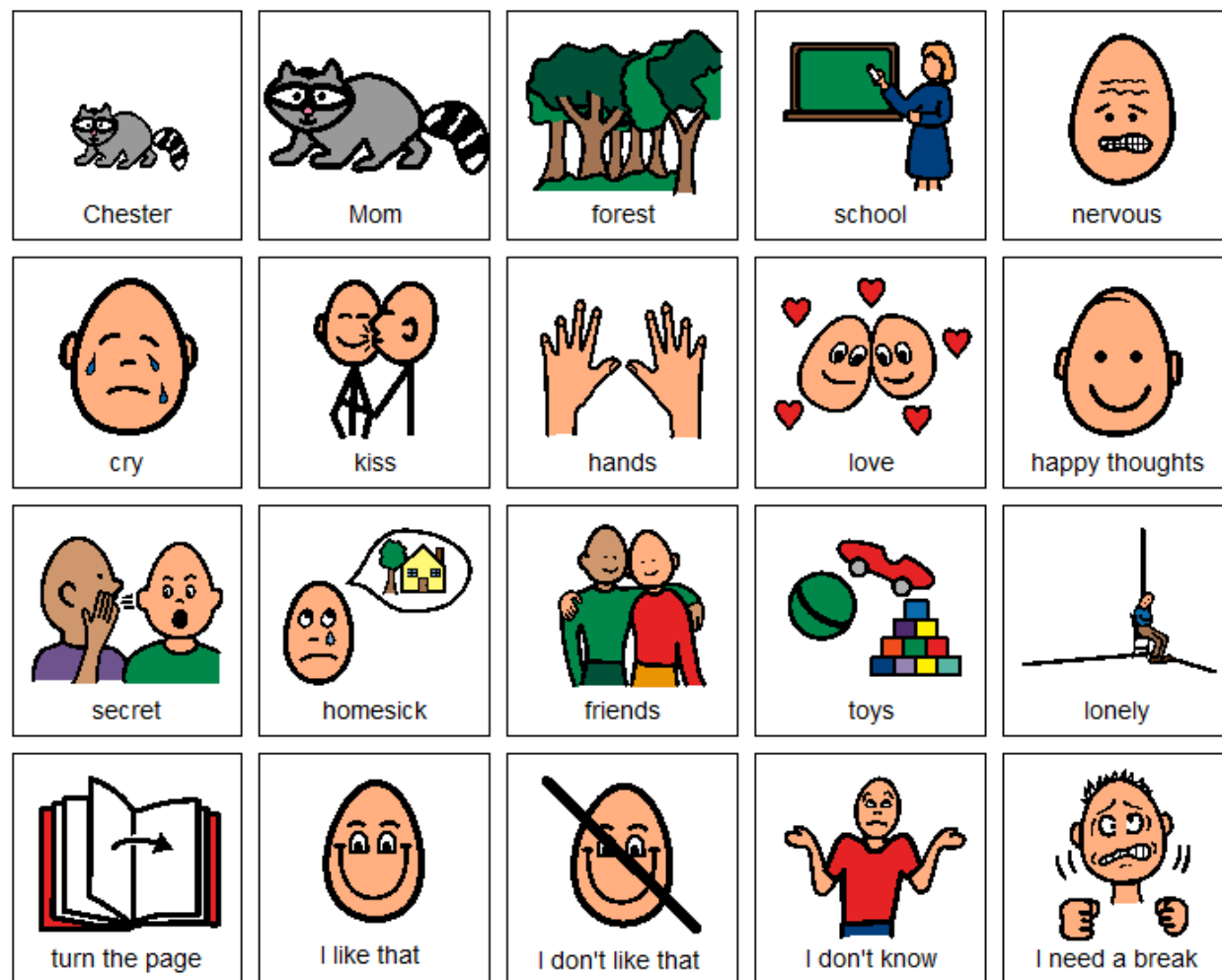

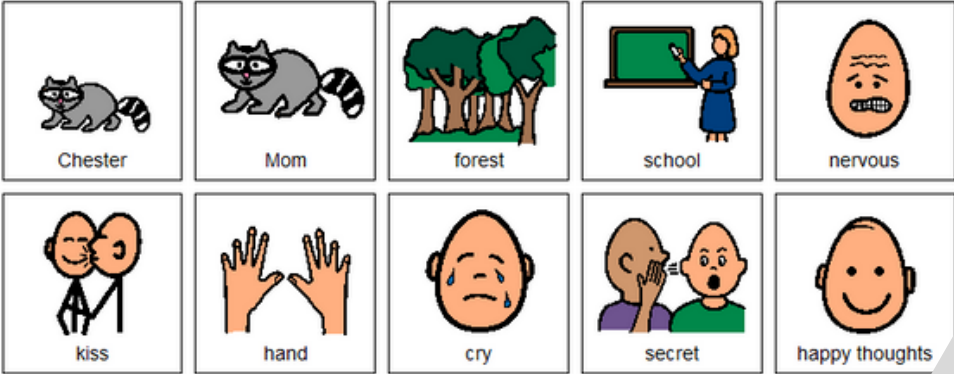

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I may get a new teacher.

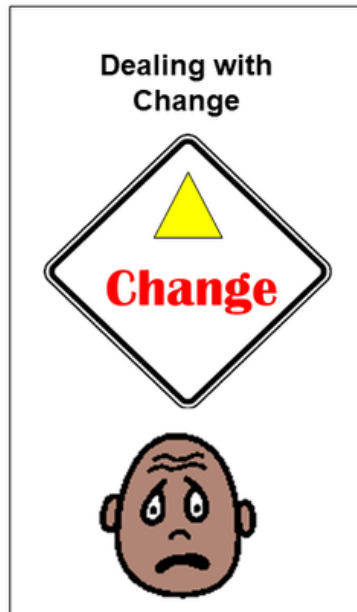


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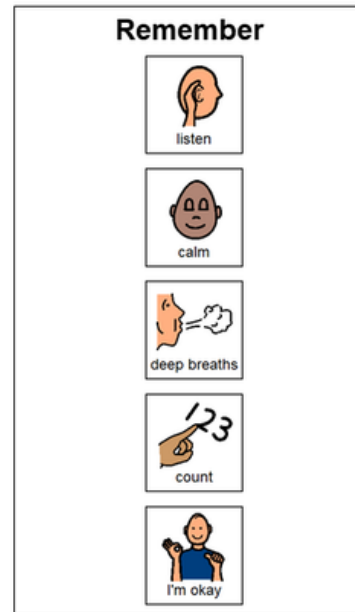
*There is a social story included in this unit about dealing with change. It has engaging photos and minimal text. Perfect for back to school.*
