

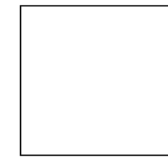

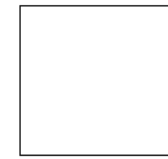

When one company totally controls the production of one product and can charge a very high price for it.



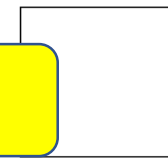
muckrakers

Group of writers who worked to expose the terrible working conditions in the factories.



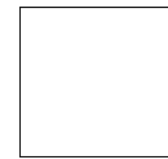
Upton Sinclair

One of the most famous muckrakers who wrote The Jungle and looked at conditions in a meat packing plant.



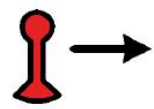
Meat packing plant
