


This unit has 34 pages plus 12 google slides. There are 5 activities to go with this book as well as a storyboard to use for group discussions.













































This unit comes with a storyboard.

Place the pictures in the circle map on previous page ONLY IF you think it is a sacrifice a soldier would have to make.



























This circle map has students think about the sacrifices soldiers have to make. There are the same errorless and non-errorless options included.

There is a writing prompt for students to complete about what they are thankful to veterans for.






