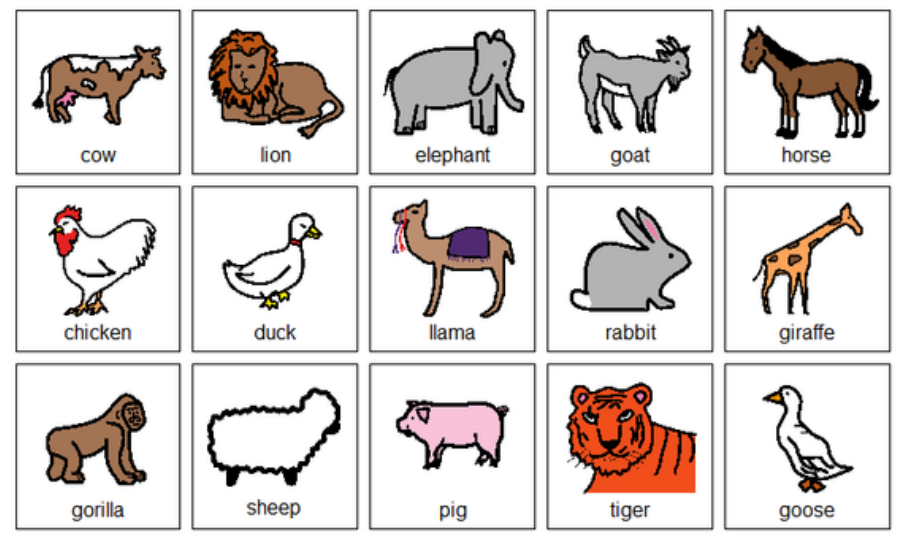
What are some animals that live on a farm?

Place the following in the circle map showing animals that live on a farm.

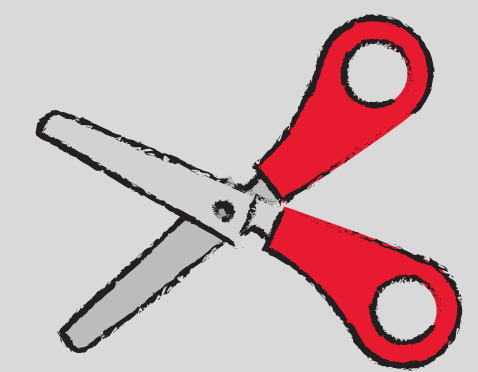


Place the following on the previous page **ONLY IF** they are animals that live on a farm.

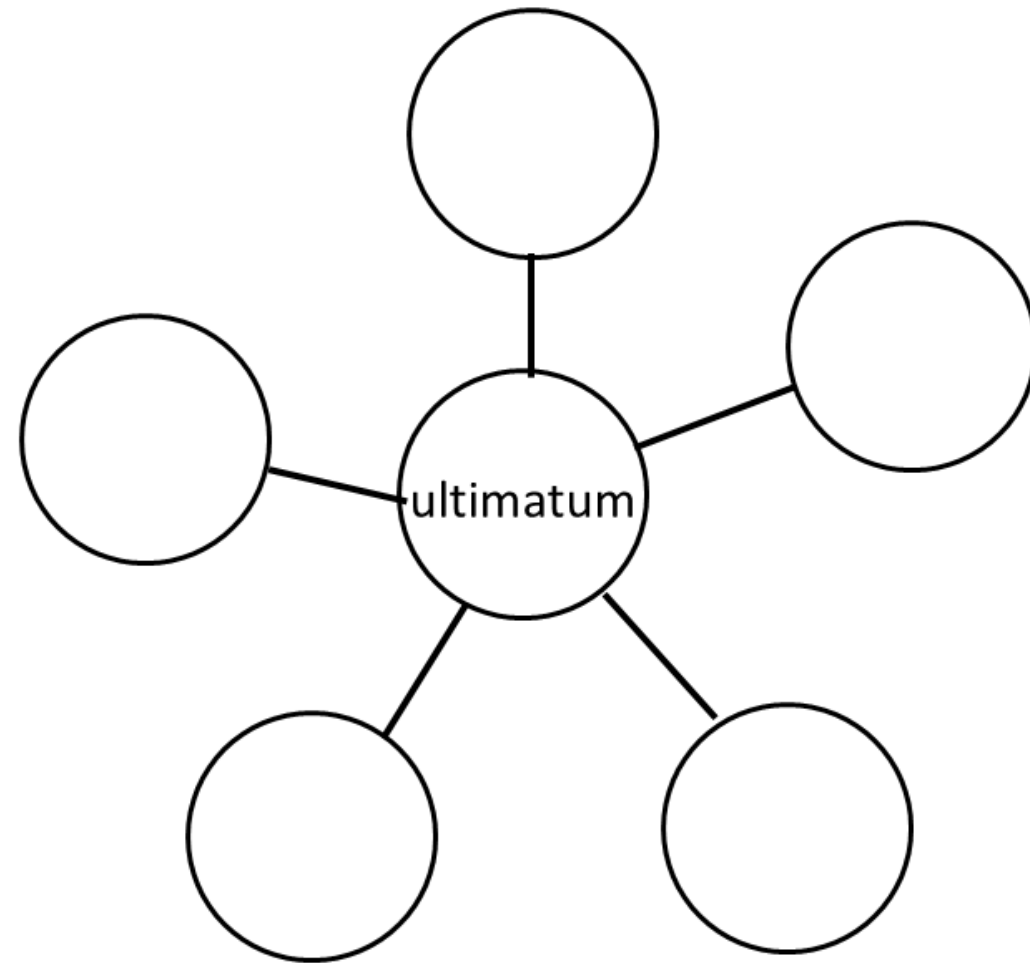


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There is a circle map showing animals that live on a farm. There is an option that only has correct answers and one that has wrong answers mixed in.

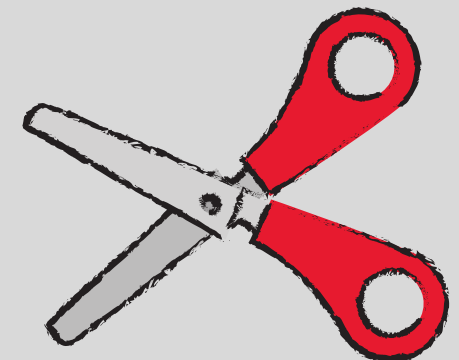

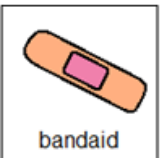
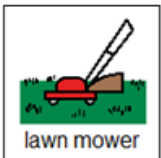
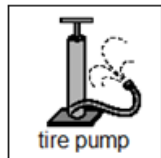
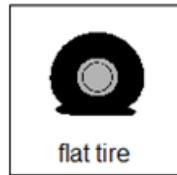
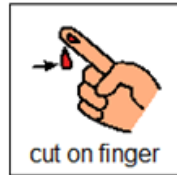
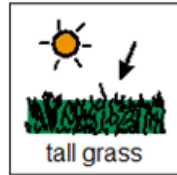
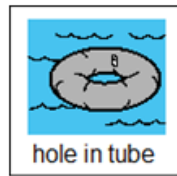


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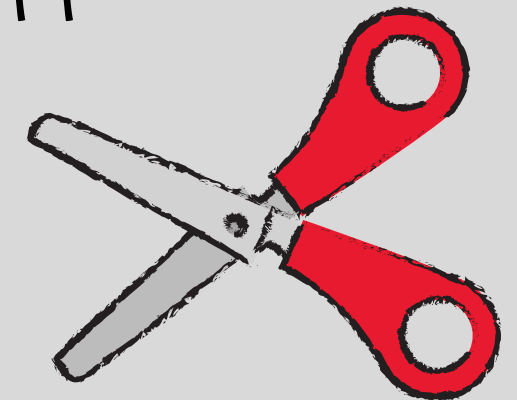
There is a word map showing what the word *ultimatum* actually means. This is an errorless activity.



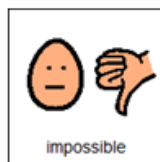
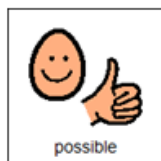
The cows and hens have a solution to their problem of being cold: electric blankets. Match the solution to each common problem below.






There is a matching activity where students match solutions to common problems. There is a color-coded option included for students who need more support.

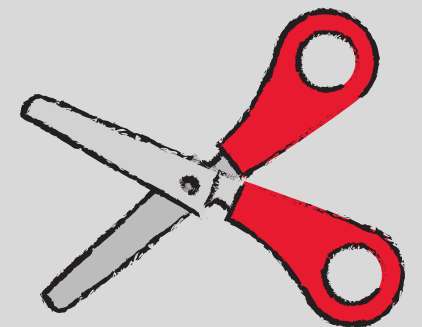

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Students will write their own letter to Farmer Brown. This is an errorless activity that allows students to write their own story independently.

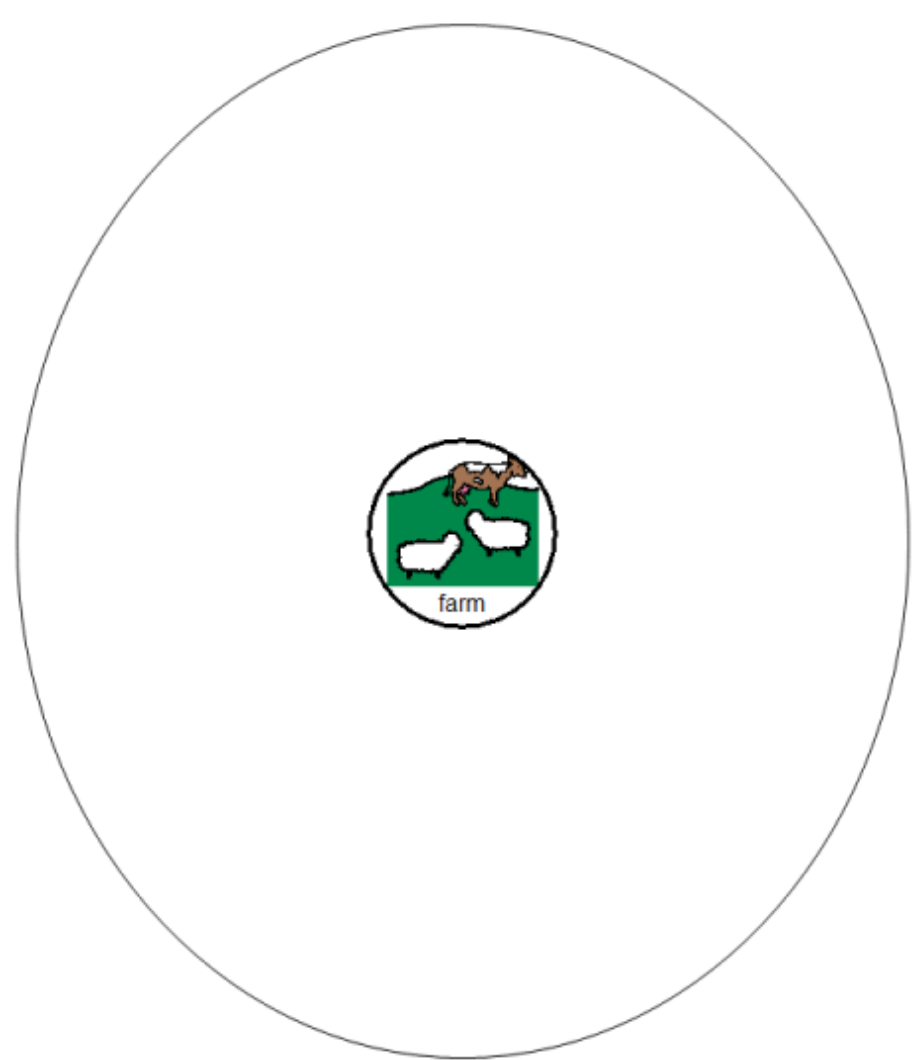

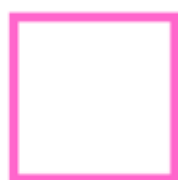
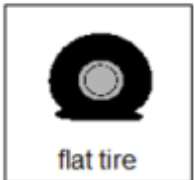
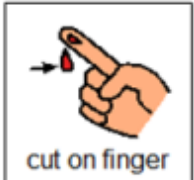
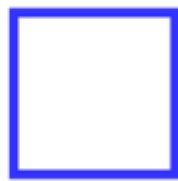
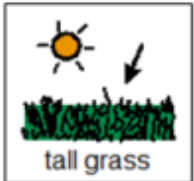
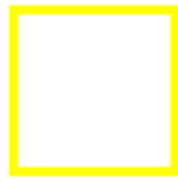
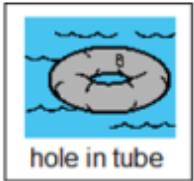




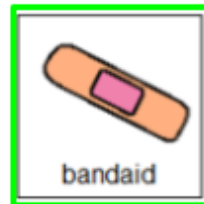
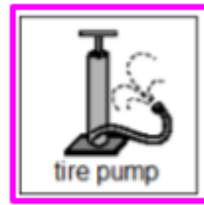
Place pictures in circle map showing animals that live on a farm.

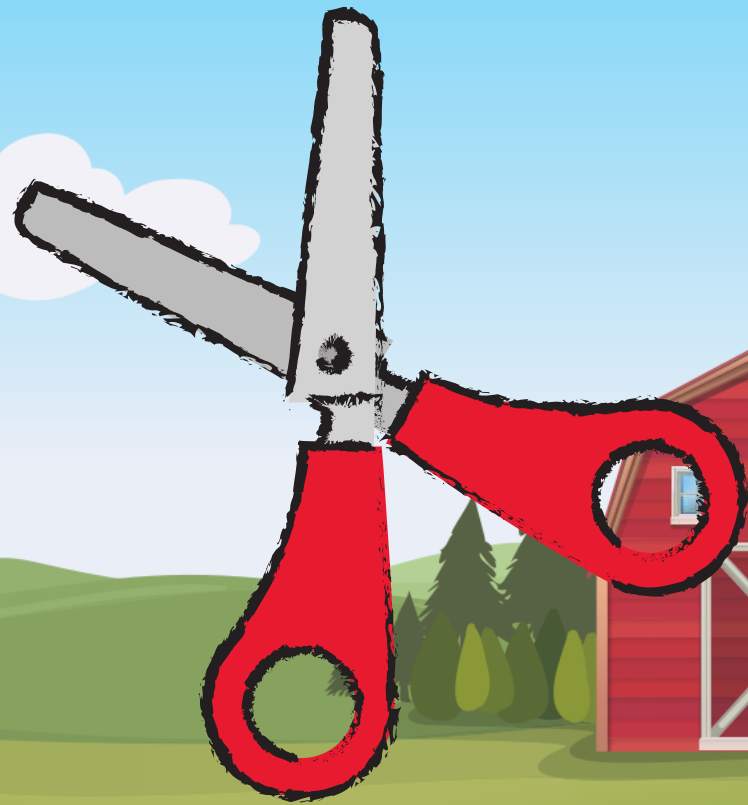
There are digital versions of the activities included. Students click and drag the answers.
