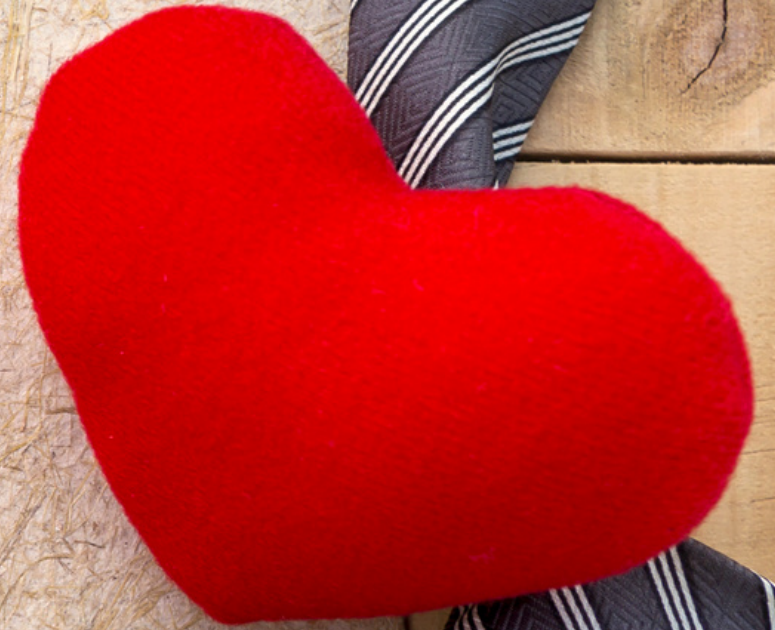

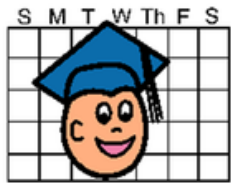

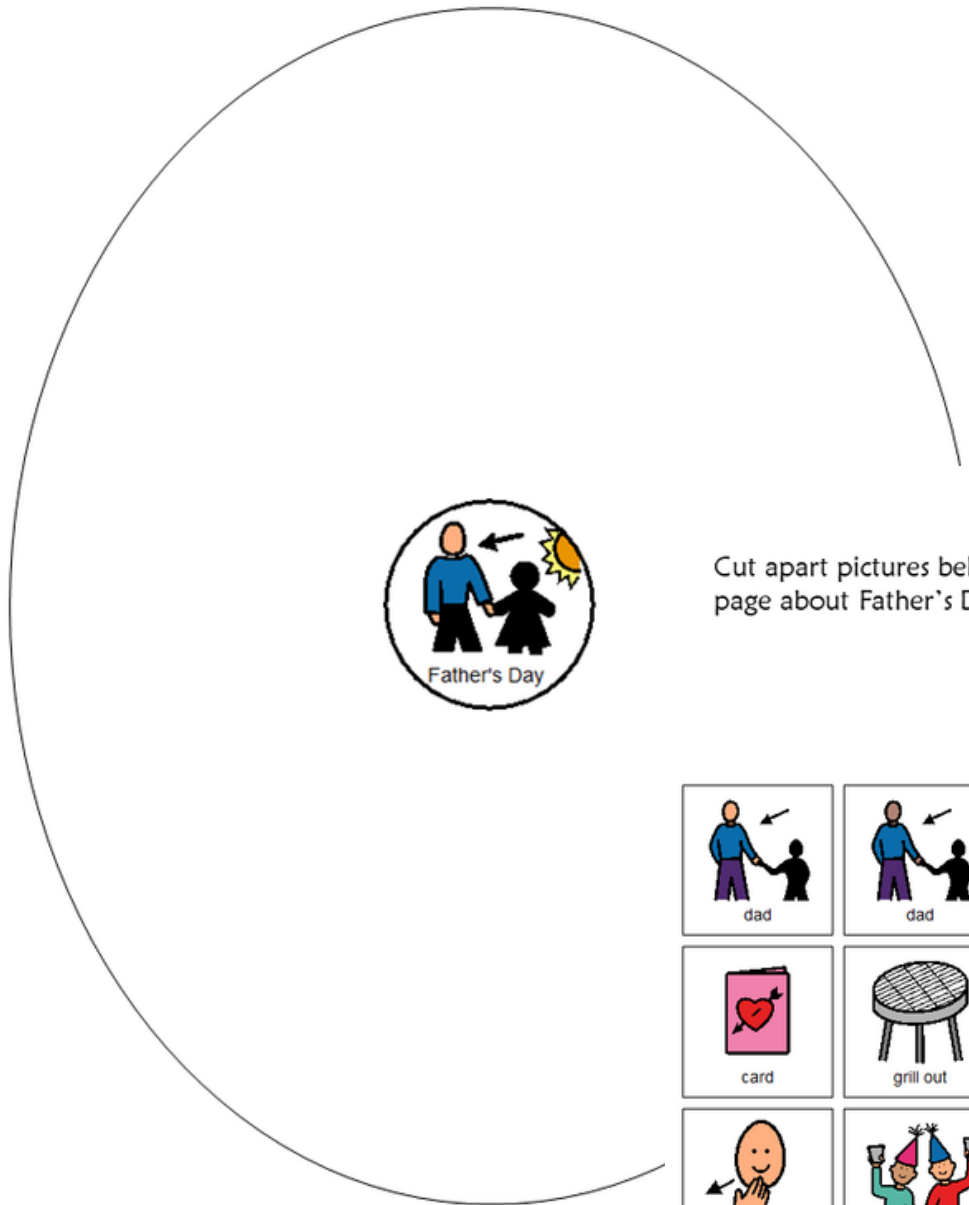
Happy Father's Day!

In 1924, President Coolidge encouraged all citizens to have a day to celebrate fathers similar to what they were doing in Spokane.

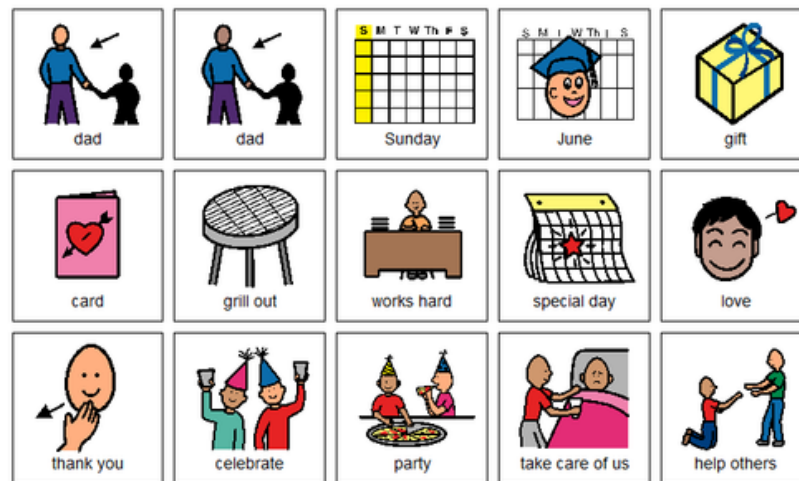


There is a 24-page book with simple text and engaging photos about the history of Father's Day and how it is celebrated around the world.
