


This unit has 30 pages plus 12 google slides. There are 5 activities to go with this book to last a full week of instruction.


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

















































This unit comes with a storyboard.

Place the signs of spring following in the circle map on the previous page.


























Place the following in the circle map on the previous page ONLY IF they are signs of spring.


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
Students will complete a word map about what prediction means. This is an errorless activity.



Sort the activities on the next page into whether you would likely do them in the spring or the winter.








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This is a sorting activity looking at things you do in the spring or in the winter. There are suggestions for differentiation.



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































Students will write a story about being a groundhog that predicts the weather. This is an errorless activity that allows students to write their own story independently.
