Place the pictures in the circle map on previous page **ONLY IF** you think it would be a common Halloween traditions.



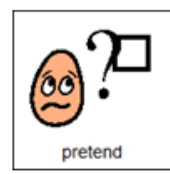



There is a circle map showing common Halloween traditions.

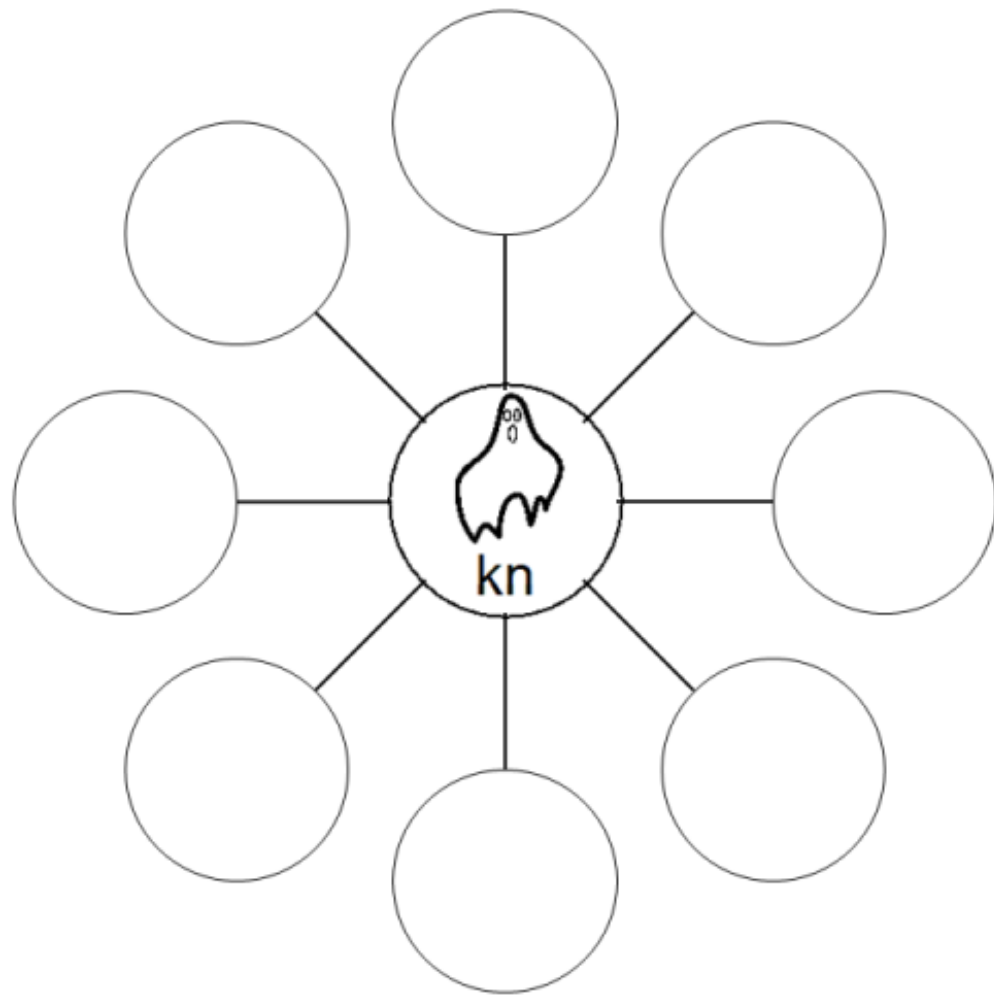
There is a writing prompt. Students will write a story as though they were dancing with a Halloween character. This is an errorless activity.

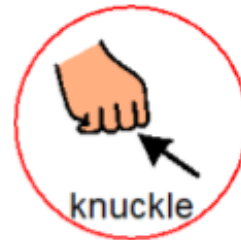

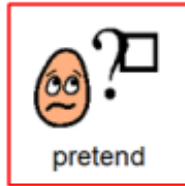
