


*This unit has 5 activities in printable and digital formats to last a full week of instruction.*

Storyboards are great for ALL students to assist with participation and engagement in group discussions.



My mom has big hind legs and a pocket for her baby.





My mom is black and white and lives in the sea. She is very much bigger than you and me.






Students will match the young animal to its mother. There are real photos and picture symbols.




In this activity, students will sort adult and young animals. Color-coding can be added for differentiation.




Because llamas have excellent hearing and vision, they are also kept to guard herds of smaller animals like sheep.






There is a circle map about llamas that is a follow-up to the non-fiction book included. There is an option that only has correct answers and one that has wrong answers mixed in.










Place pictures in the circle map about llamas.




There are digital versions of the activities included. Students click and drag the answers.
