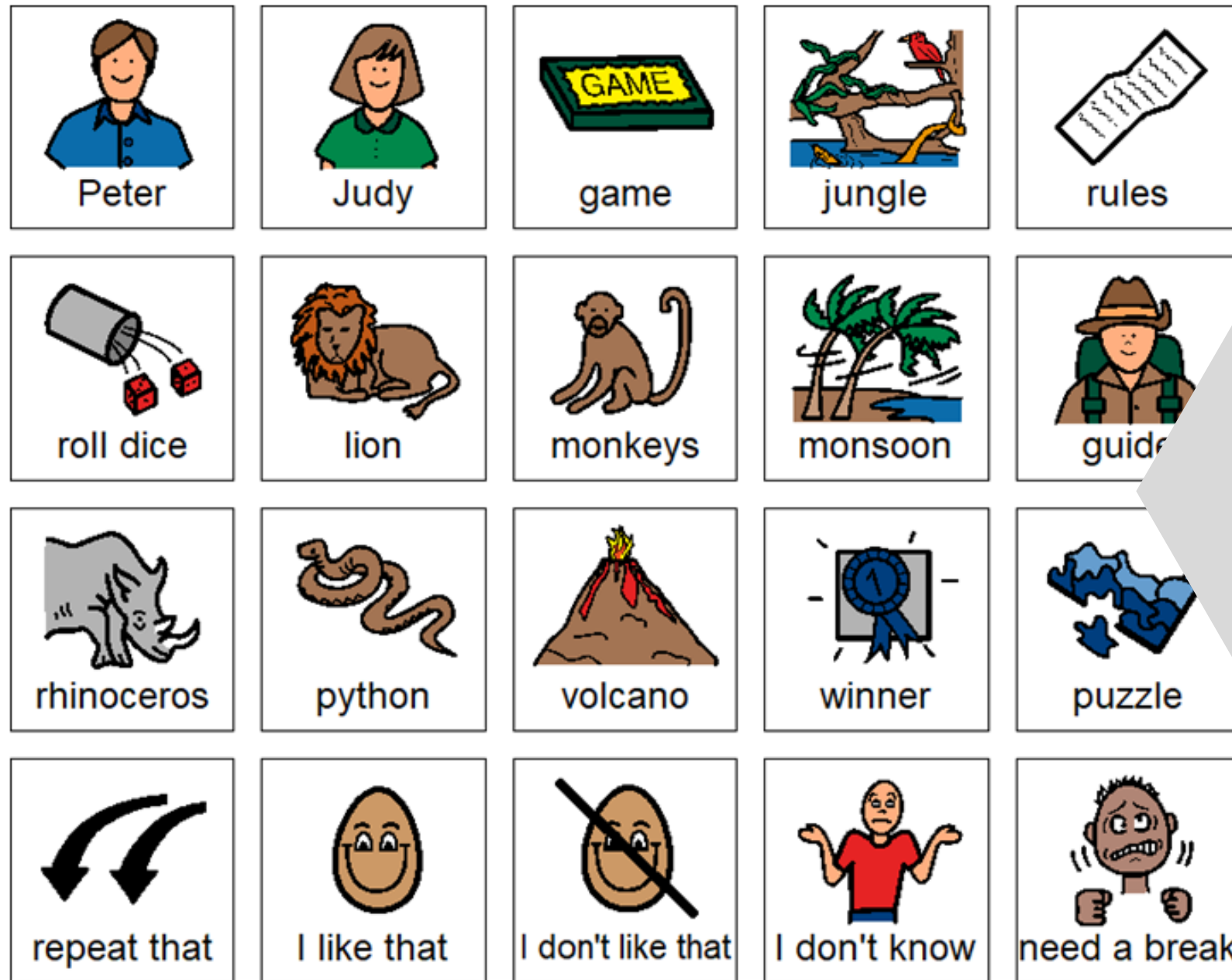

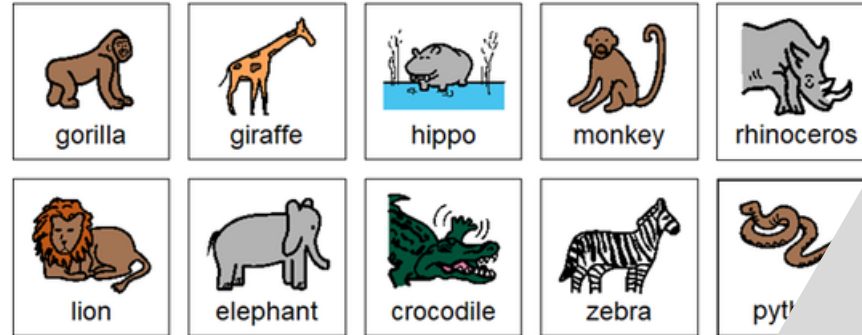
Storyboards are great for ALL students to assist with participation and engagement in group discussions.

Errorless option

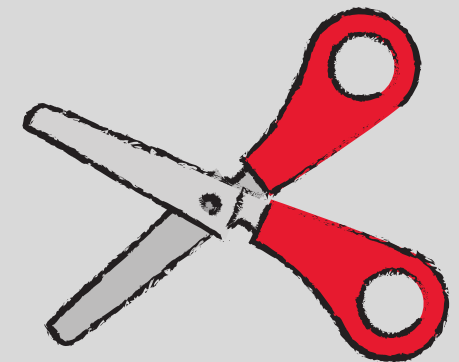
Place pictures in the circle map showing animals that live in the jungle.



Cut out the pictures and place in the circle map on the previous page **ONLY IF** they are animals that live in the jungle.

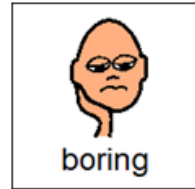


There is a circle map showing animals that live in a jungle. that There is an option that only has correct answers and one that has wrong answers mixed in.

Answer may vary.

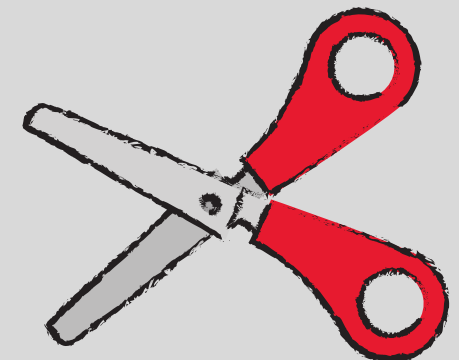

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Students will sort things they think would be exciting and those that would be boring. Suggestions for differentiation are included.



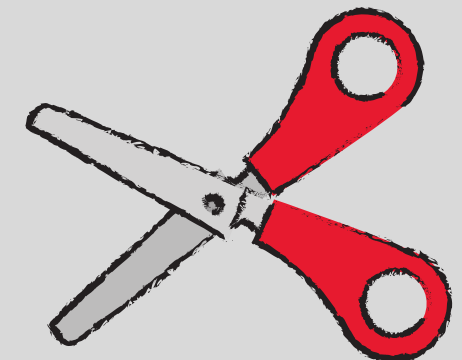


Some parts of this book are real, and some were in the imagination of Judy and Peter. Sort the things from the book that were real and those that were not.

There is a sorting activity where students sort real and imagined things from the story. Suggestions for differentiation are included.













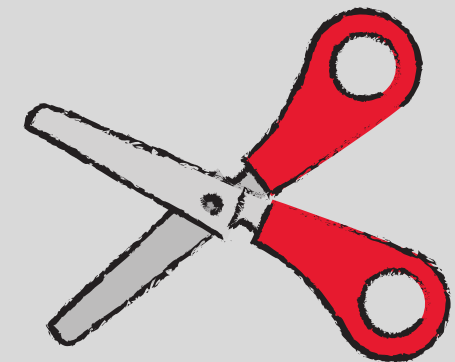
Look at each item used to play a certain game. Match the game to the playing piece. You can only use each game one time.

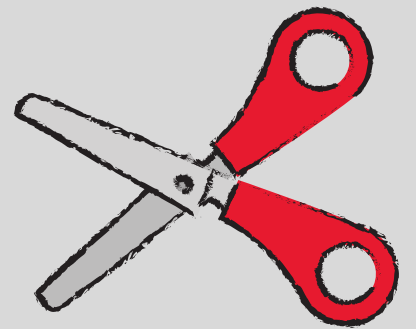

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Students will write a story about playing a Jumanji game. This is an errorless activity that allows students to write their own story independently.

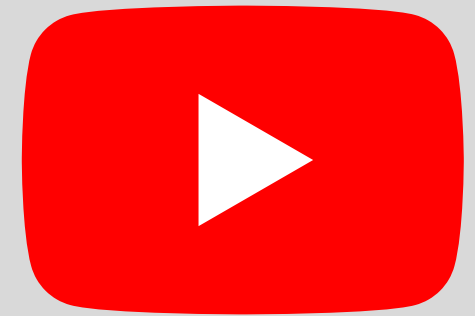
