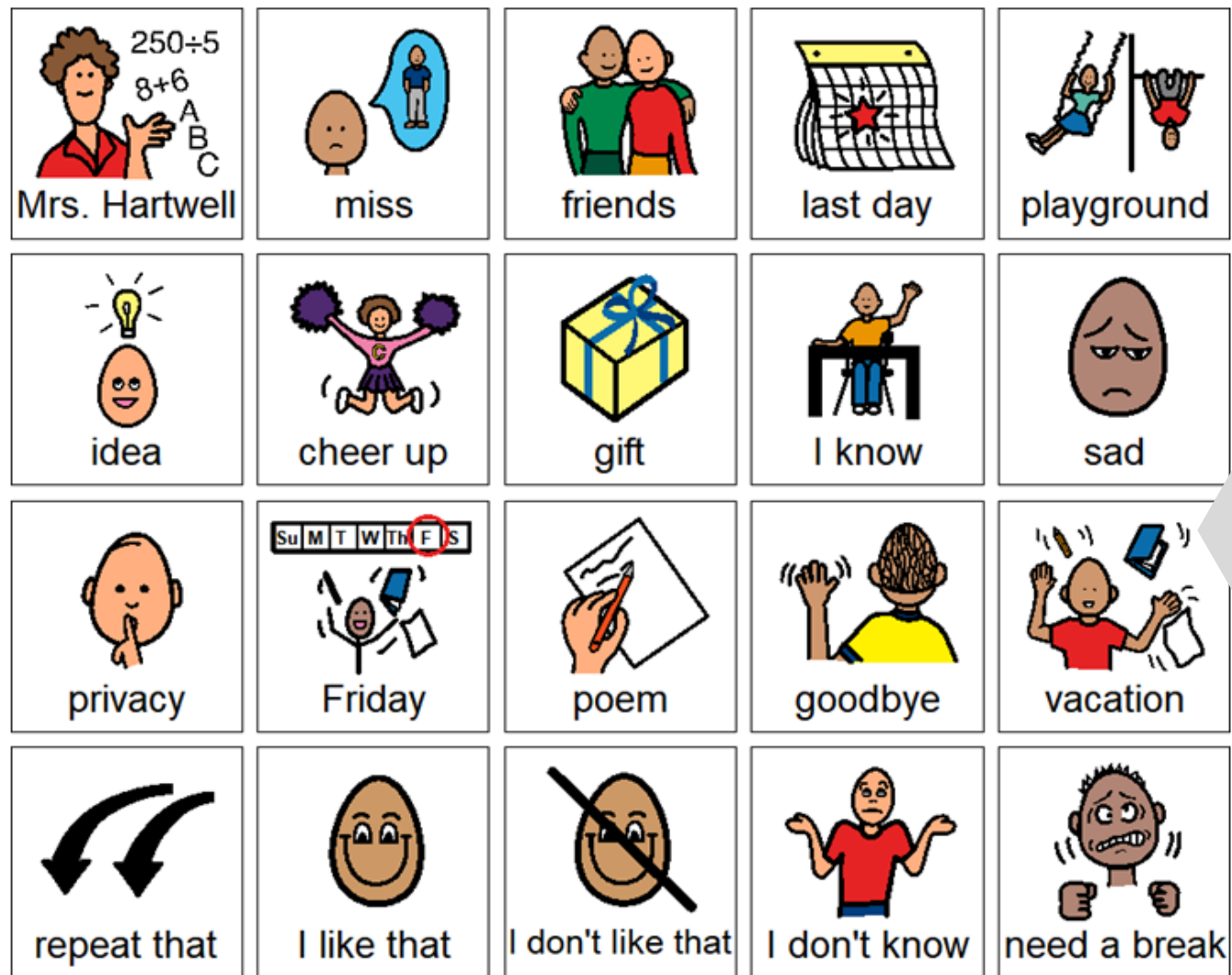
There are 5 activities to go with this book to last a full week of instruction.

Storyboards are great for ALL students to assist with participation and engagement in group discussions.

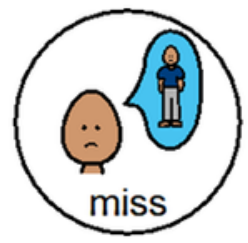
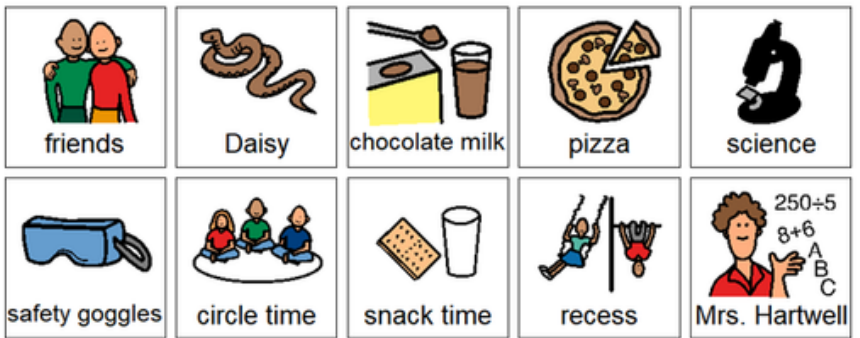

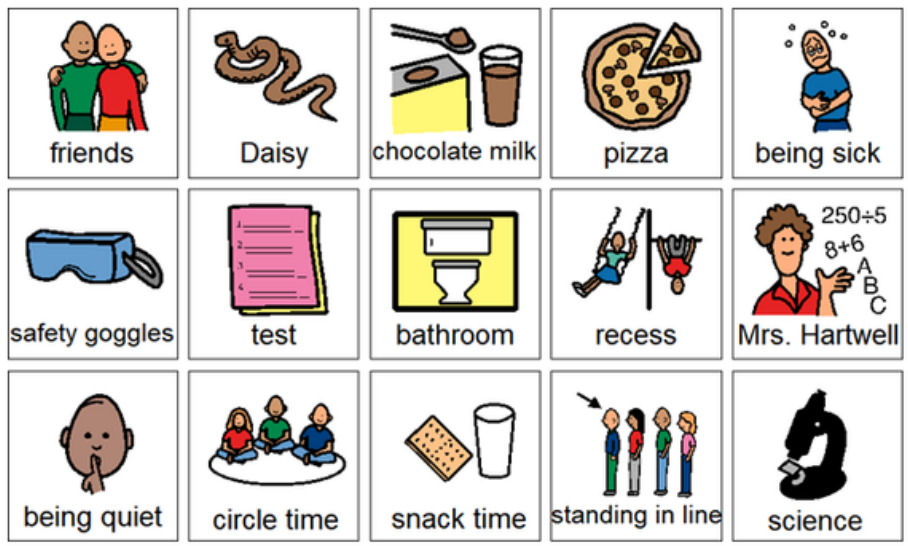
# Activity #1

Place the pictures in the circle map on previous page **ONLY IF** you think they are things the students will miss.













There is a circle map showing the things the kids say they will miss. There is an option that only has correct answers and one that has wrong answers mixed in.

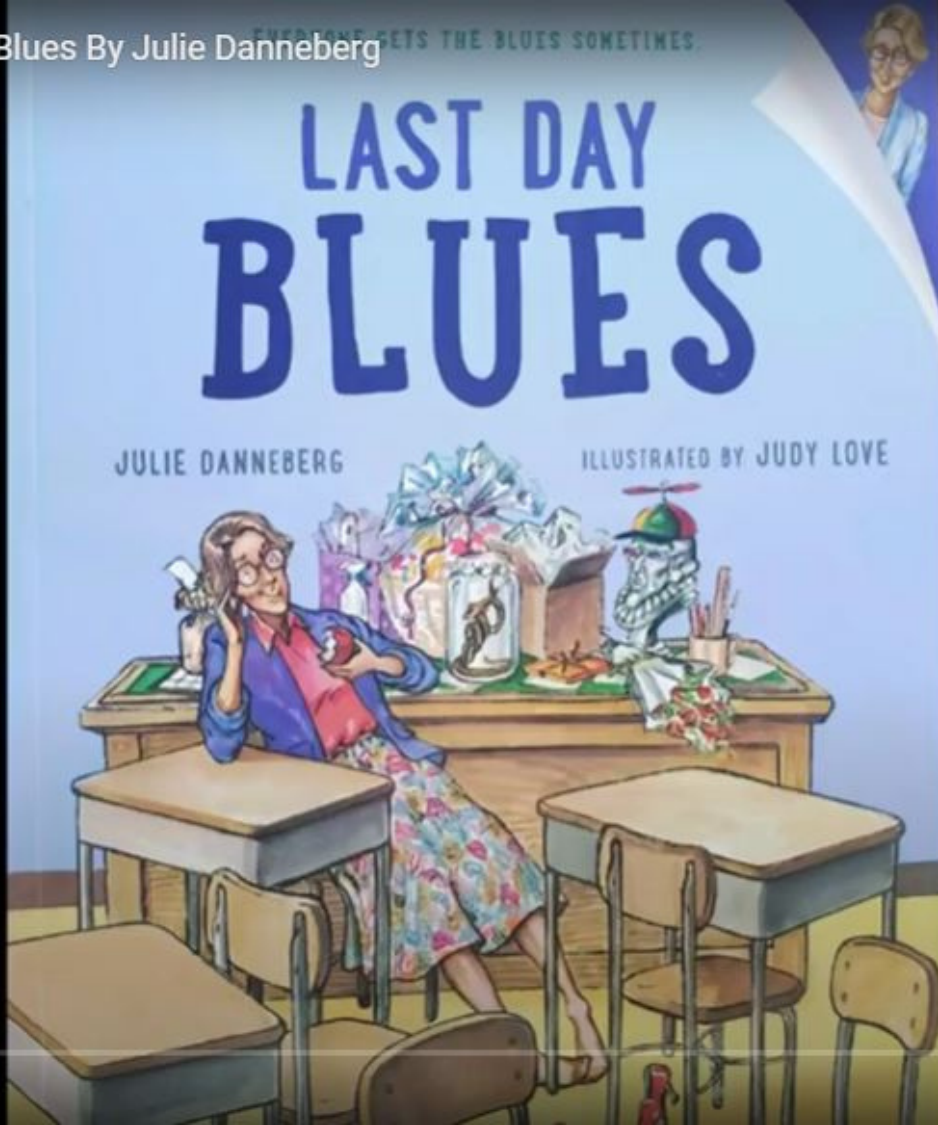


# Activity #5

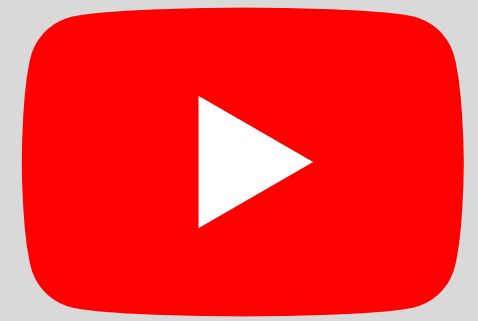



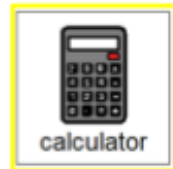
