There is a 21 page social story that has simple text and engaging photos. This story is in a PowerPoint and Google Slide format so you **can edit** the text if needed to fit your own situation.

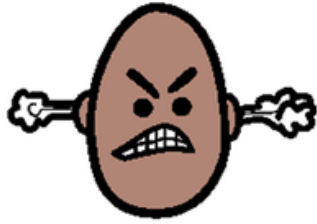
There are many kids in my school and in my class.

Sometimes, things make me , especially when it seems unfair.

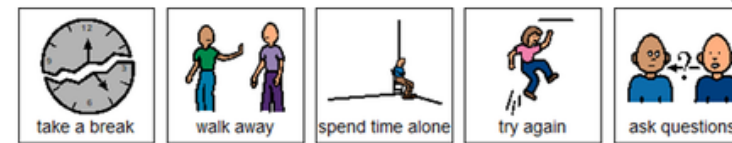

There is a power card that comes in 2 versions that reviews what to do when you get upset because things don't seem fair. These are great for students to carry around and personalize.



There is a sorting activity about good and bad choices when you are upset. Suggestions for differentiation are included.

2. A way to informally assess if students are comprehending the material.

3. Engages the student by providing different ways to review the same material.
