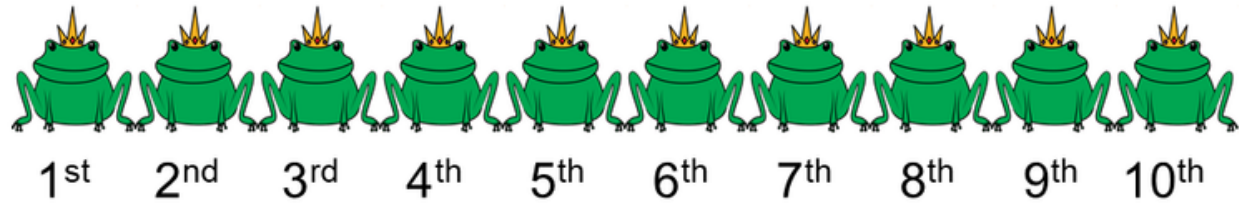

Read or listen to the movie version of Keeping Order (book 1) (5 minutes)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The first time students are seeing the book, focus a lot on the pictures<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ask lots of questions about what they might think the pictures mean or may relate to• Make connections between book and previous knowledge	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Book
Group Activity (15 minutes)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will practice placing things in the correct location on the templates according to ordinal position• See activity for complete directions and suggestions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Templates• Manipulative• Dry erase markers

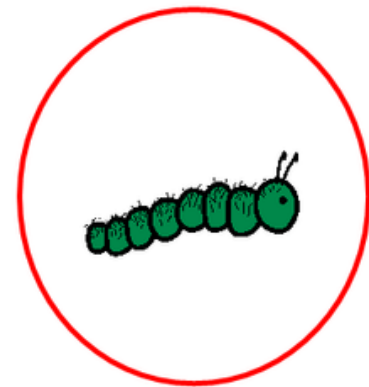

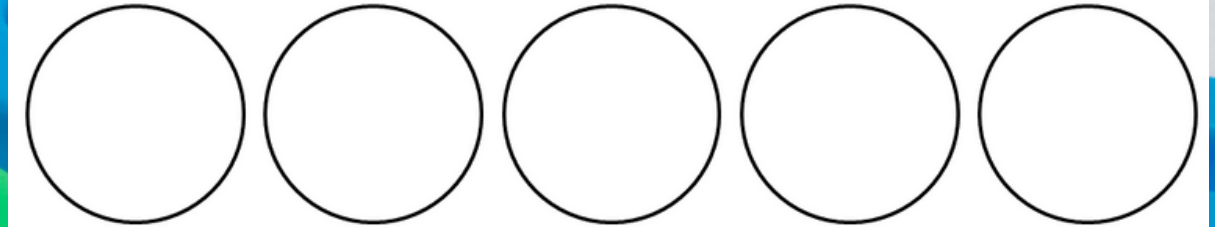
They come in a PowerPoint version as well as a voice-recorded movie (mp4).

Group Activities: Ordinal Ten

Group activity

- These templates are meant to be an aid during small group instruction.
- Print onto cardstock or mount on construction paper and laminate.
- There is a version with the ordinal values written in light gray.
- Use various counters and have students practice putting the counter in the correct location on the template.
- I used different shapes to help in the generalization of the concept.
- Suggestions for use:
 - Indicate where to put each counter, ie put the green bear first, yellow bear last
 - Have one student place one manipulative in each space, and another student indicate which is in each ordinal position
 - This is great if you have students who cannot yet identify ordinals, but are in your group. They all feel included.
 - Fill template, and have students take away certain ones based on ordinals.

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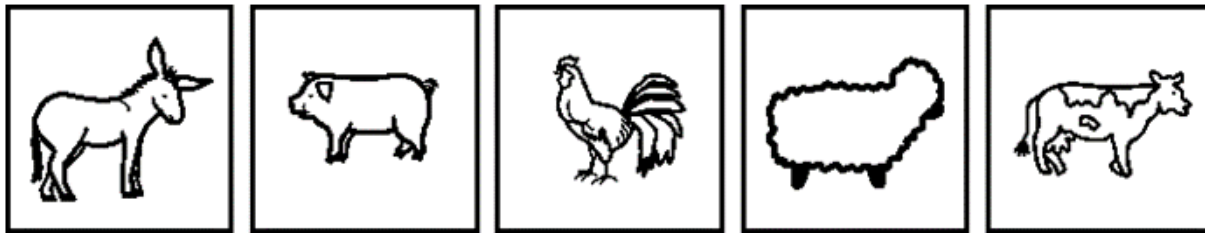


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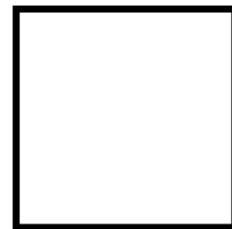
