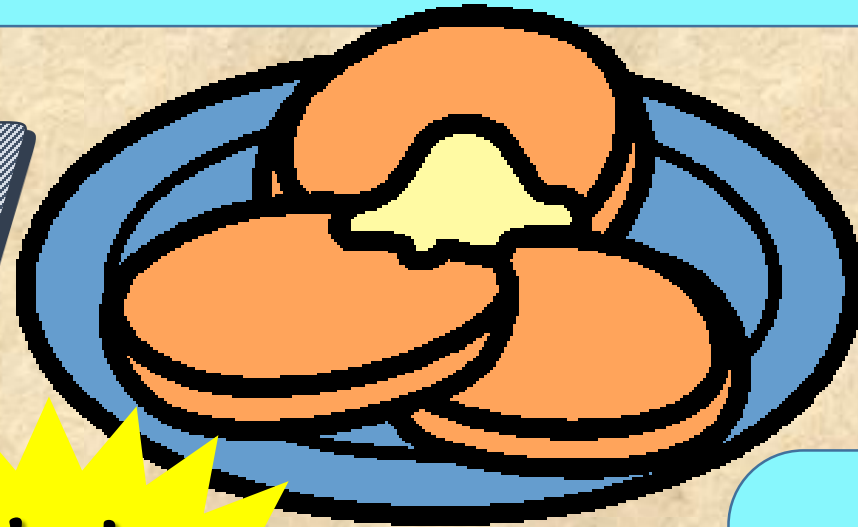

Farming tool that turns cream into butter

Farming tool with curved blade to cut the wheat

Farmer who grinds the wheat into flour




**Vocabulary cards

Hard shell that surrounds the grain of wheat





Materials:

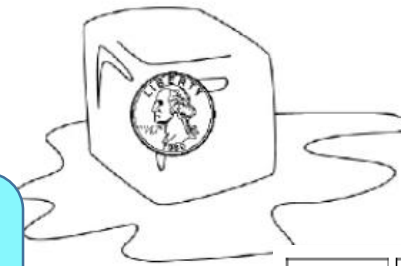
- an ice cube for each student with a quarter frozen inside
