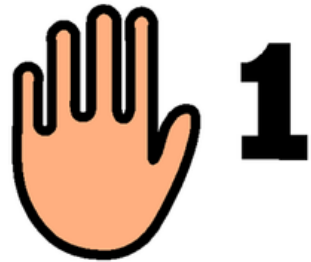

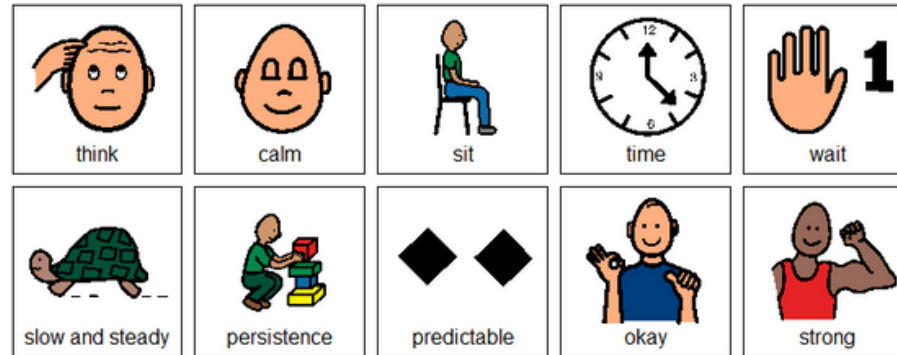
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There is an 10 page booklet using picture symbols that students can take home.

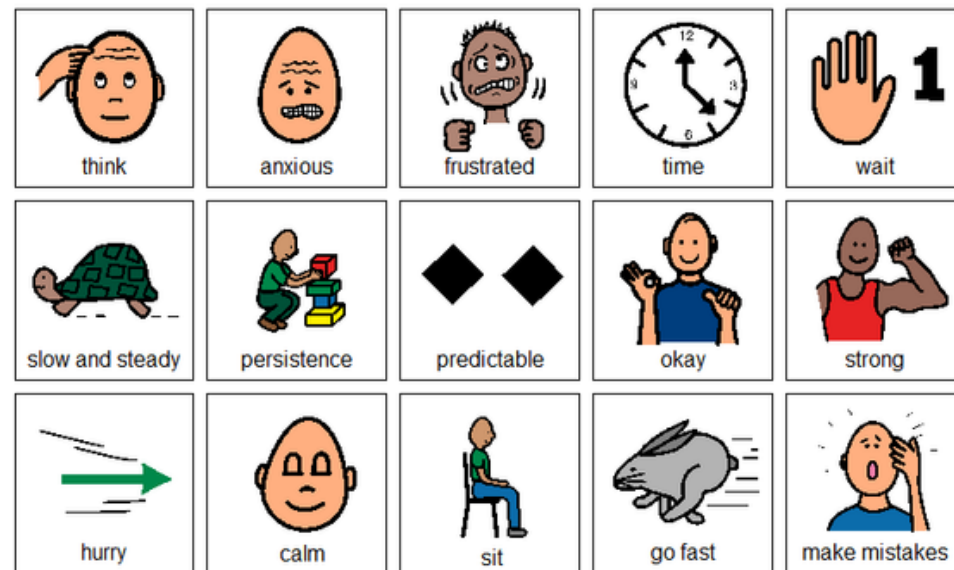
What does patience look like?

Place the pictures in the circle map on previous page **ONLY IF** you think it describes patience.



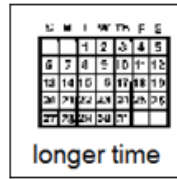

There is a circle map on what patience looks like.

Circle maps are a great way for students to see the concept at a glance. There are 2 versions:

- One is errorless
- One has wrong answers mixed in students will have to set aside

Some activities take a short time and some take a longer time. Sort the activities into the best column depending on how long it will take.



 drink a glass of water	 eat lunch	 nap	
 finish puzzle	 bus ride to school	 eat a cookie	 empty trash
 watch a commercial	 take a bath	 color a picture	 basketball game
