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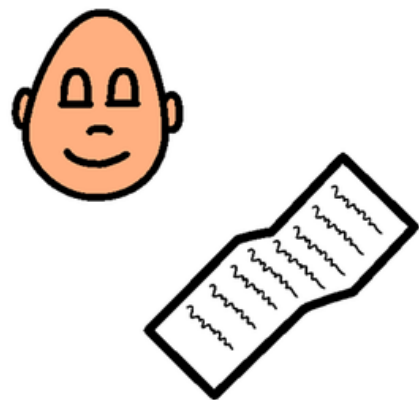
I wait for the bus to stop.



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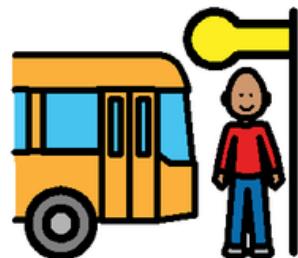
There is a 10 page social story that has simple text and engaging photos. This story is in a PowerPoint and Google Slide format so you **can edit** the text if needed to fit your own situation.

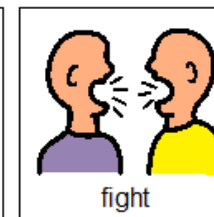
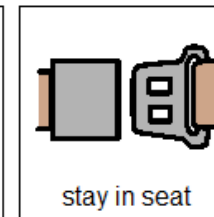
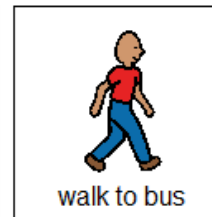
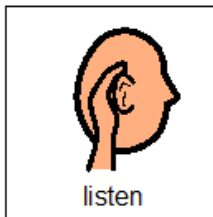
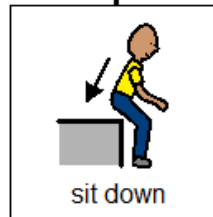
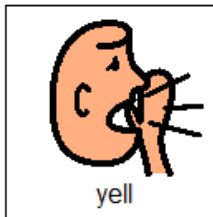
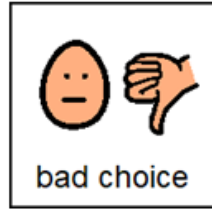


Back of card



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There is a power card that comes in 2 versions that reviews what to remember about riding on the bus. These are great for students to carry around and personalize.



There is a sorting activity about good and bad choices when riding the bus. Suggestions for differentiation are included.
