






These activities do NOT require students to understand what is being read, or are errorless.

There are 5 activities for each book.







Each unit has digital versions of the activities that make great independent learning centers.

There are 2 sets of google slides. One is differentiated with color.























































Circle maps are one type of activity to go with the literacy units.

Each circle map comes with 2 choices:


An errorless option with only correct answers

Look at the activities and decide if it would be better to do them on a rainy or a sunny day.








































Sorting activities are one type of activity to go with the literacy units.



There are matching activities for many of the read alouds.







There are writing prompts for most of the books.

Each book has at least 5 different activities that will support the text and keep students engaged for a week.






Listen to the book Busy Spring read aloud


Each book has digital versions of the activities.
