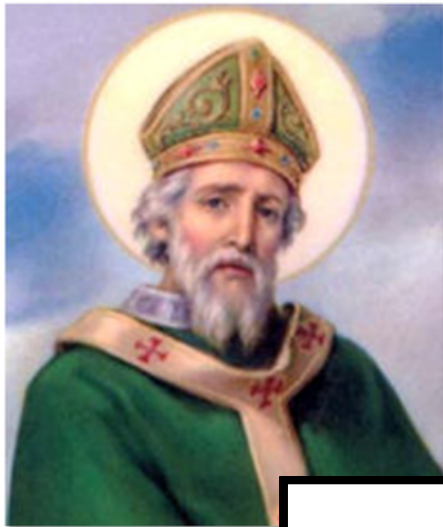

- One has wrong answers mixed in students will have to set aside

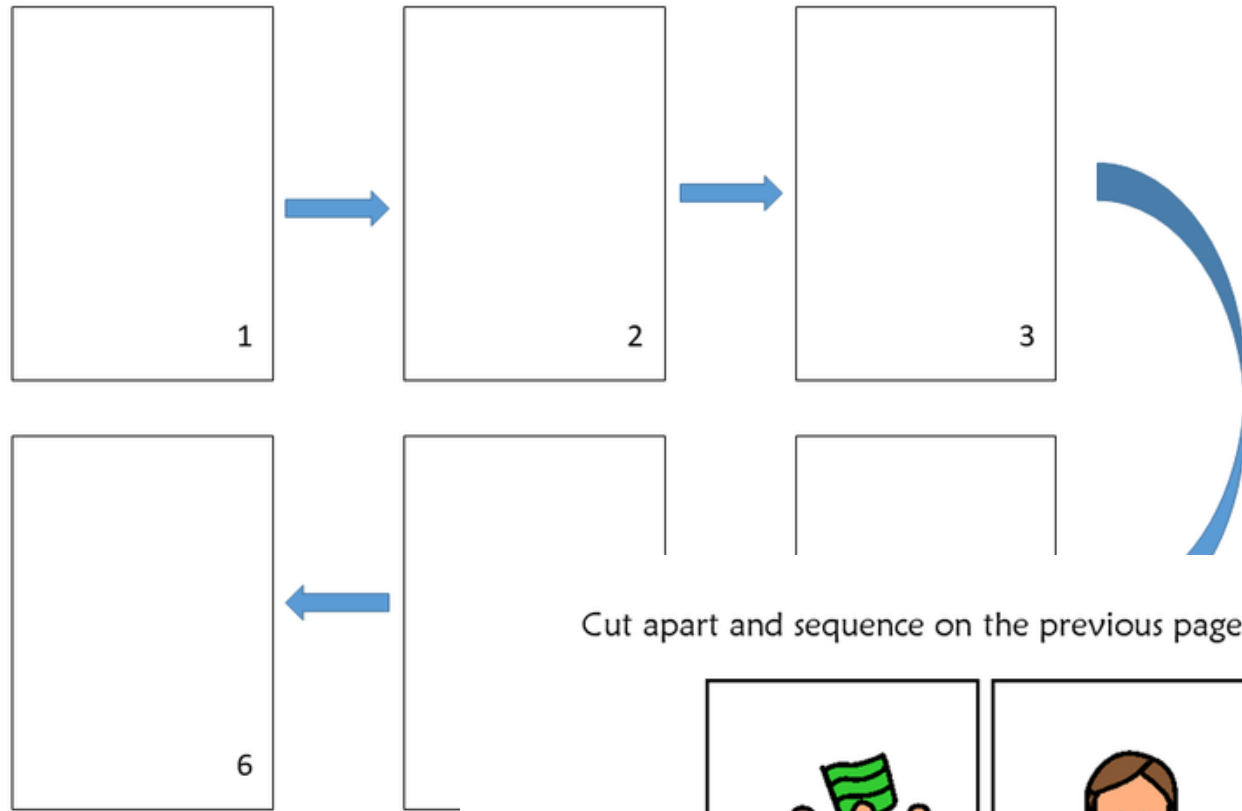

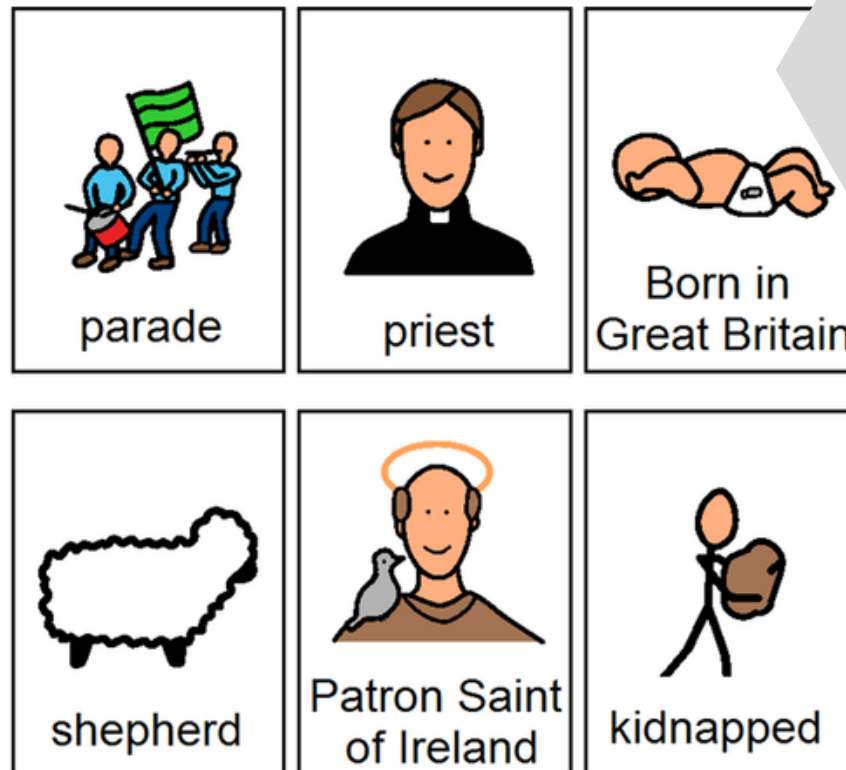

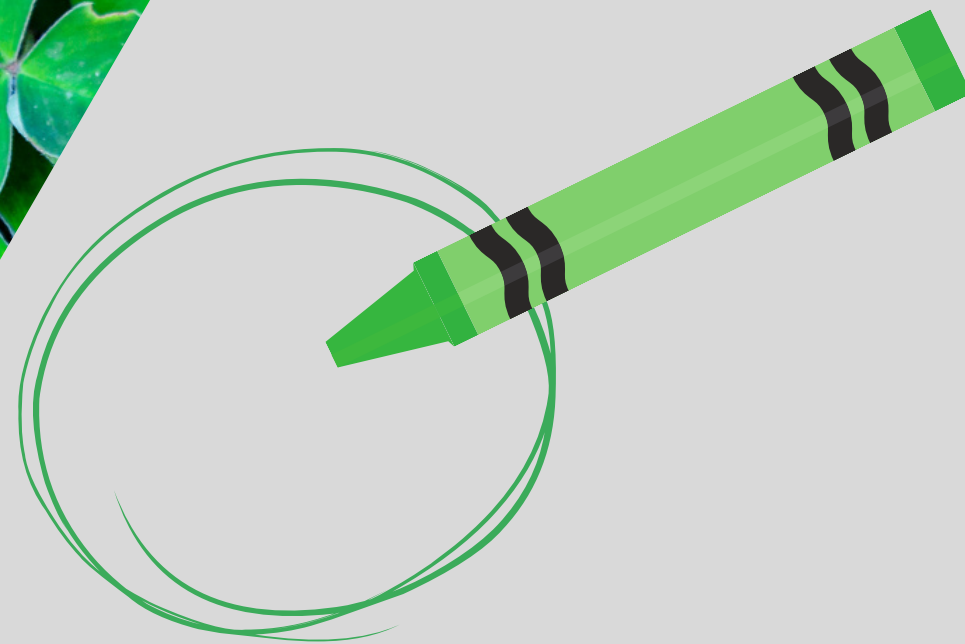
