

There are a lot of symbols and trathat surround this holiday.








Place the pictures in the circle map on the previous page. shephero Place the pictures in the circle map on the previous page ONLY IF they relate to St. Patrick's Day.

There is a sequencing worksheet about the life of St. Patrick. There are suggestions for differentiation included.










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Related to St. Patrick's Day

There is a simple worksheet where students will color in squares related to St. Patrick's Day.























































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
Sorting green things




