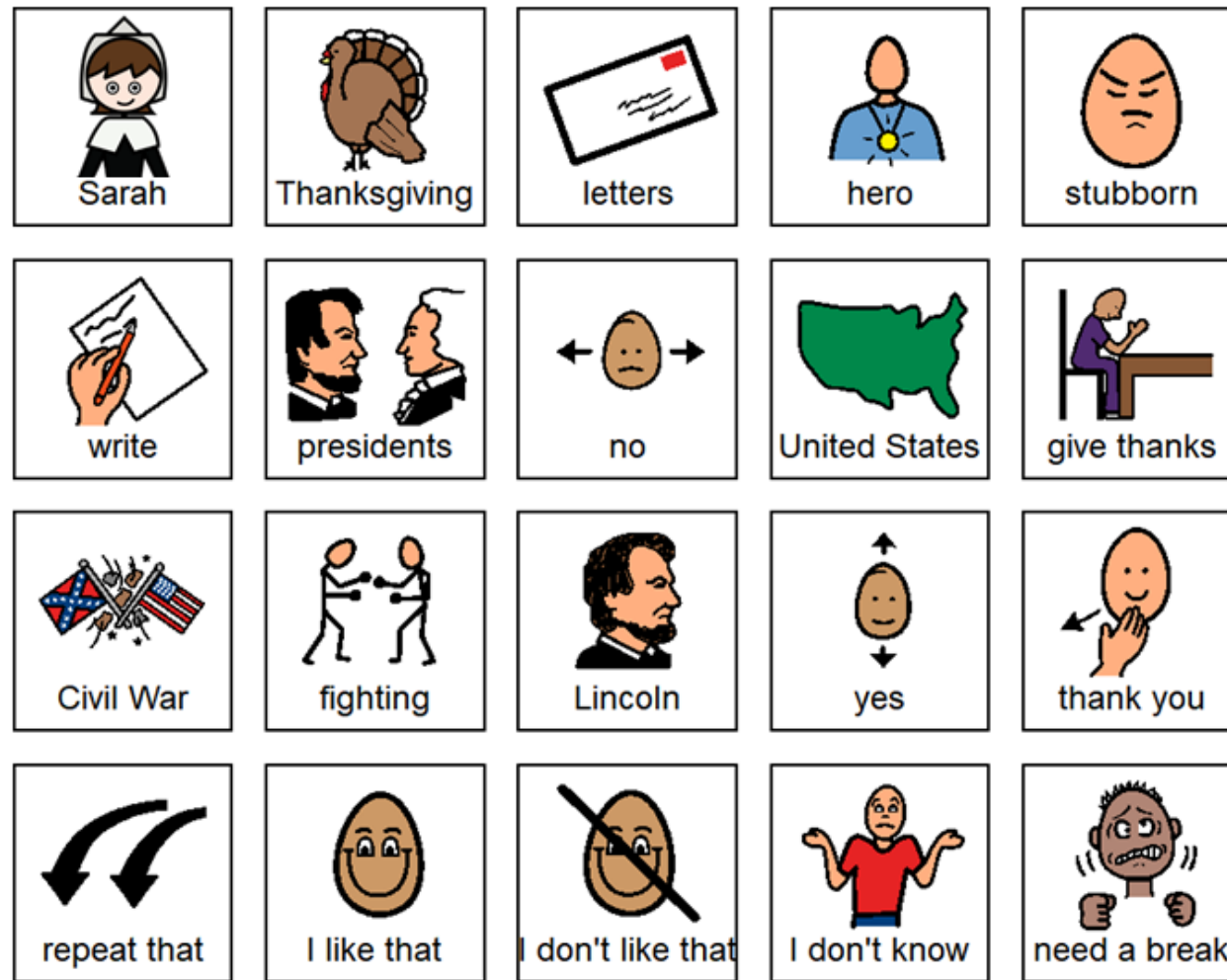

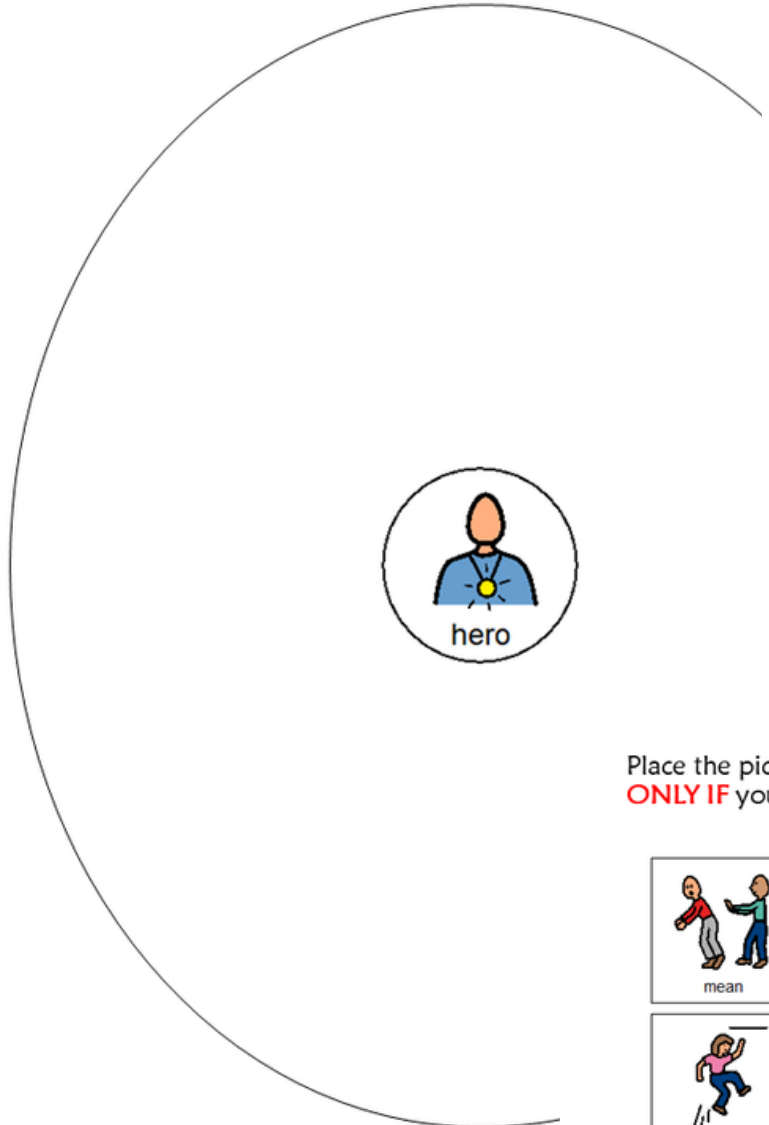
Storyboards are great for ALL students to assist with participation and engagement in group discussions.

Place the pictures in the circle map on previous page showing what a hero looks like.

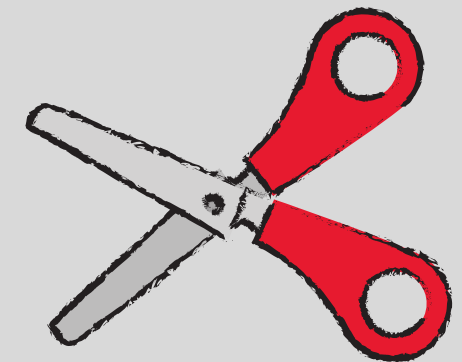


Place the pictures in the circle map on previous page **ONLY IF** you think it describes someone who is a hero.

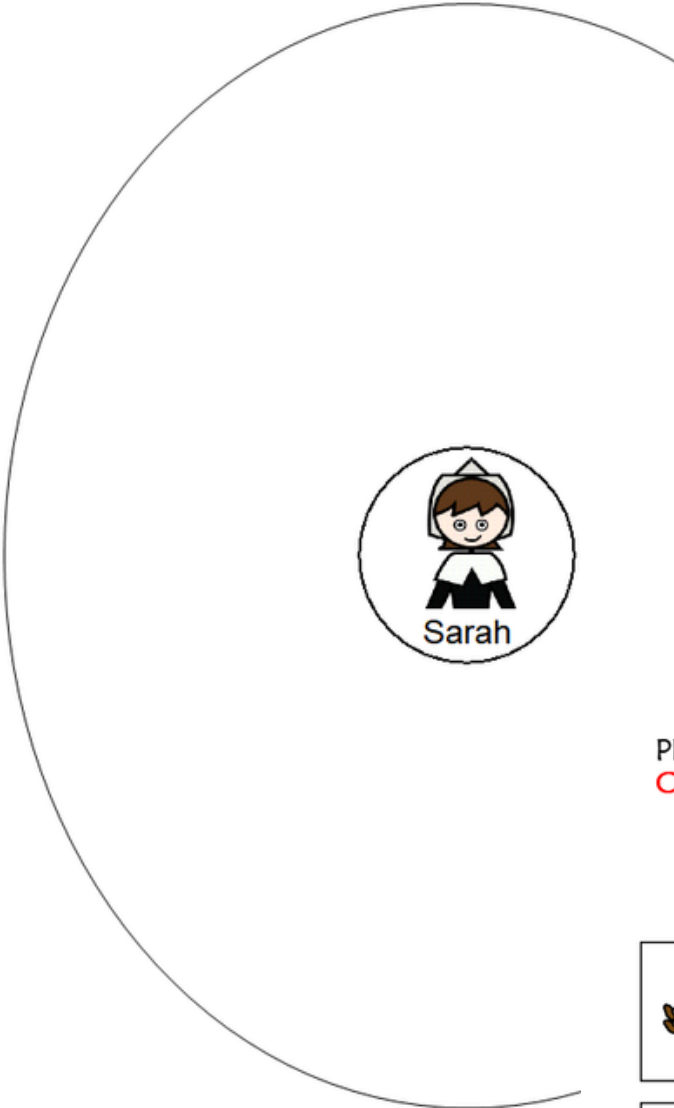


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There is a circle map showing what makes a person a hero. There is an option that only has correct answers and one that has wrong answers mixed in.

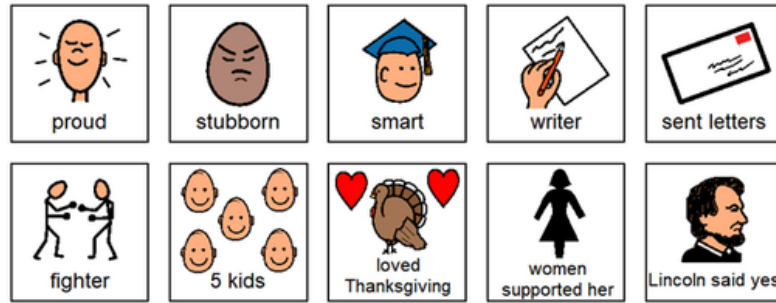


Who was Sarah Hale?

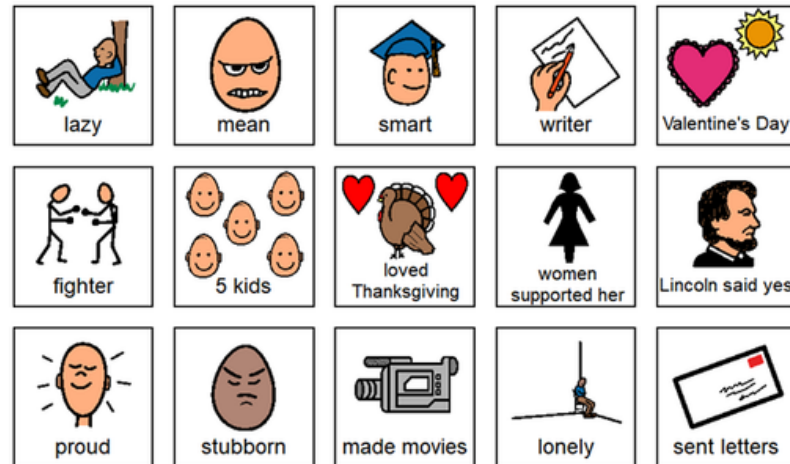


Errorless version

Place the pictures in the circle map on previous page showing who Sarah Hale was.

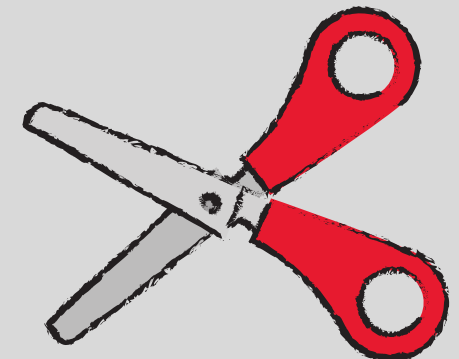


Place the pictures in the circle map on previous page **ONLY IF** they are true about Sarah Hale.

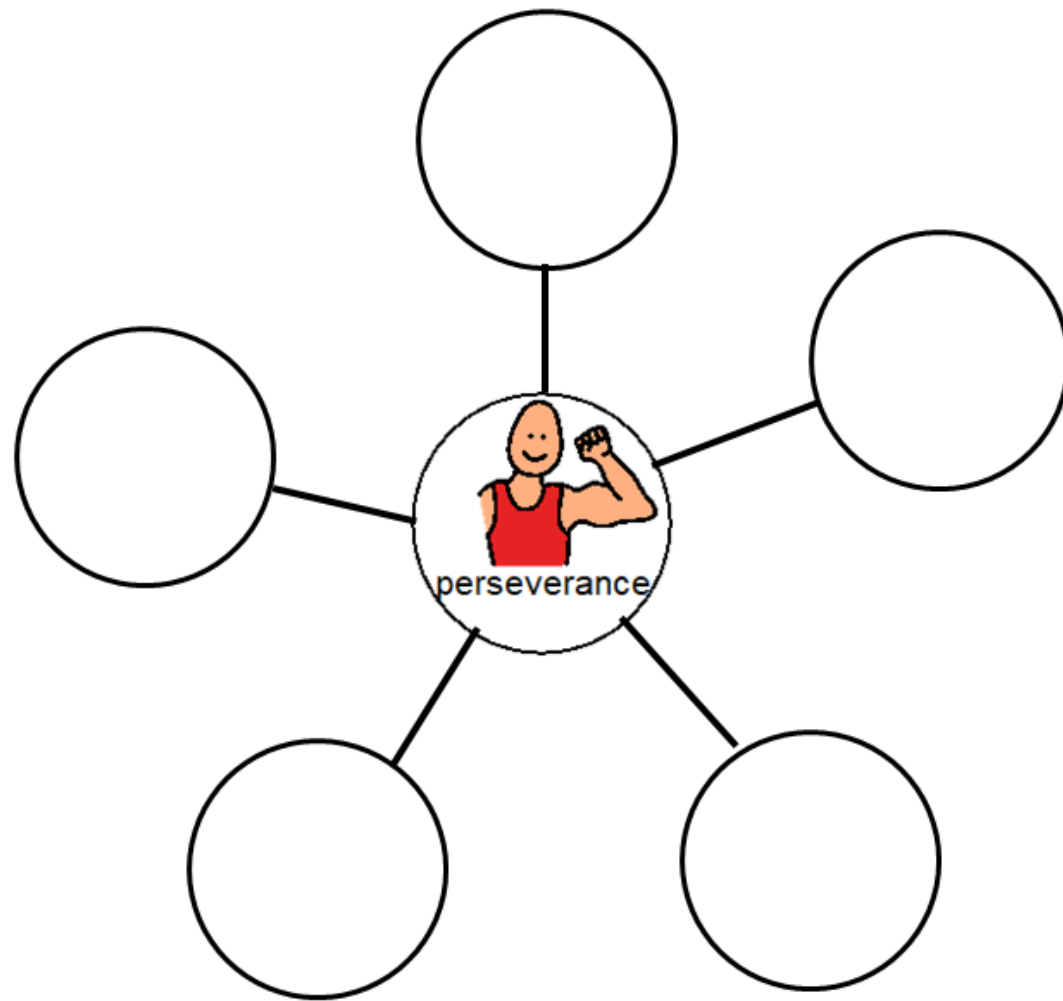


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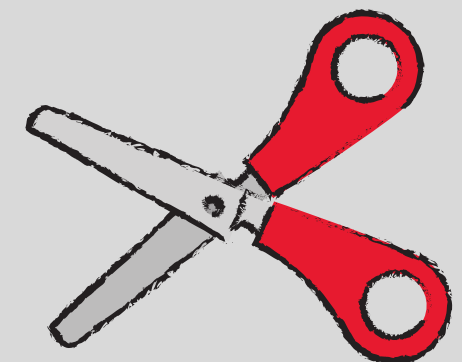
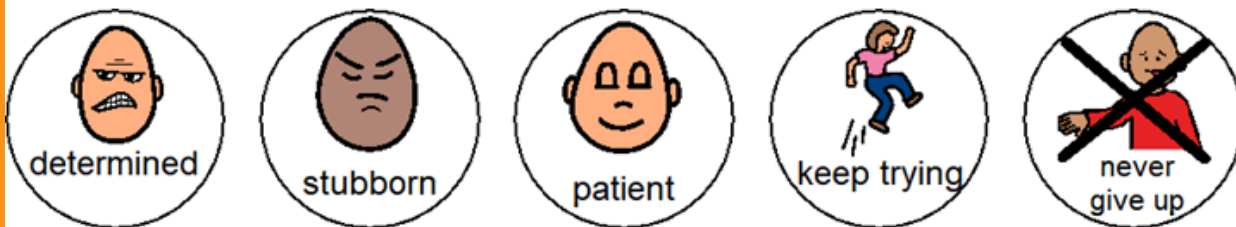
There is a circle map showing facts about Sarah Hale. There is an option that only has correct answers and one that has wrong answers mixed in.

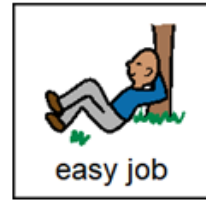
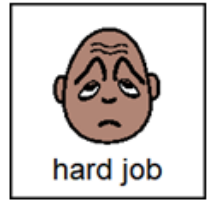


What does perseverance mean?

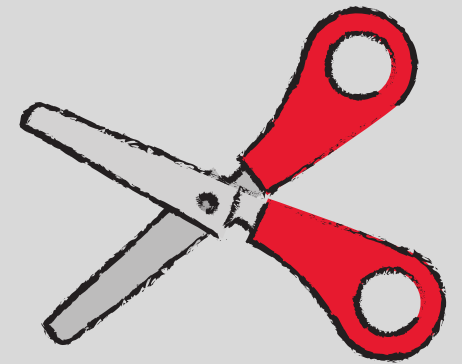

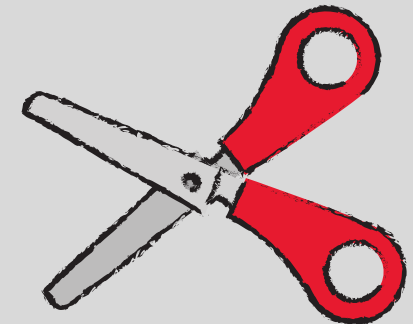

There is a writing prompt. Students will write a letter to their legislator (similar to what Sarah did) sharing something that is important to them. This is an errorless activity.



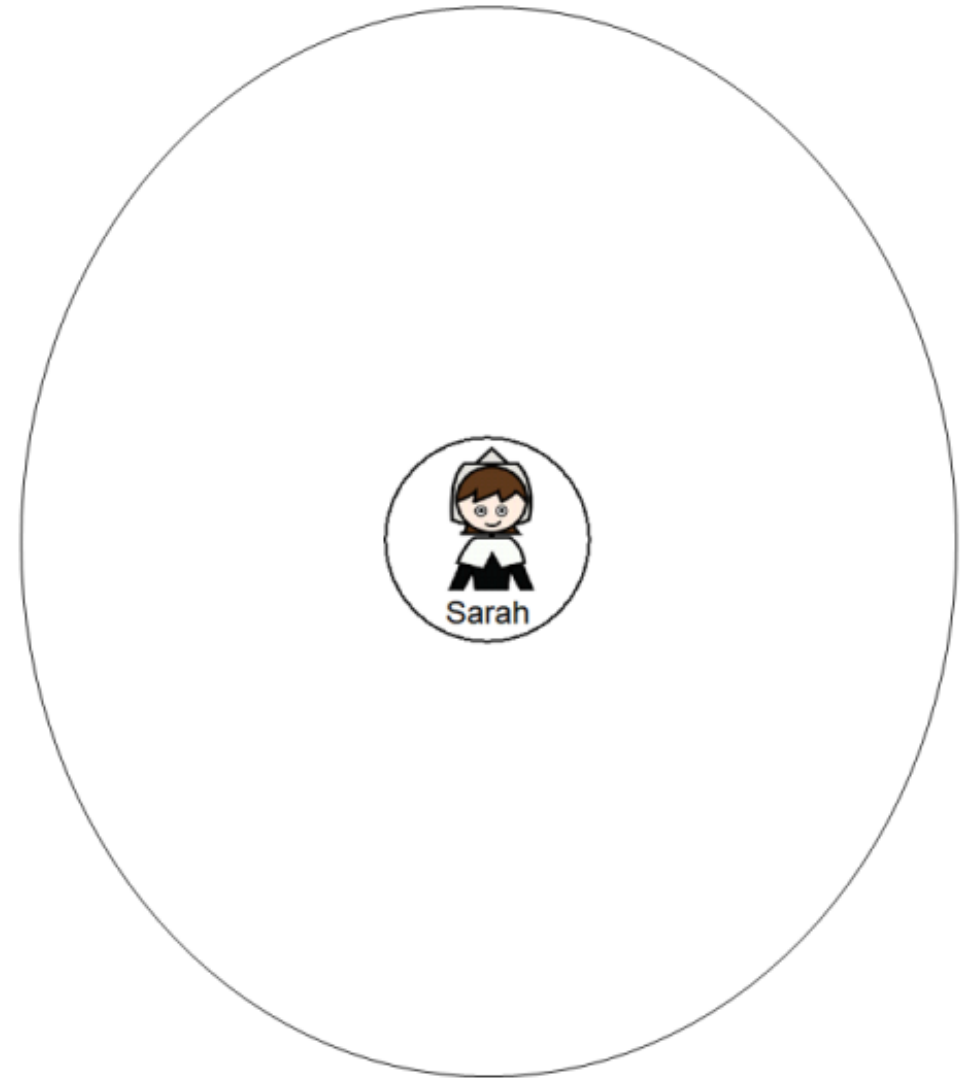










Place the following in the circle map showing some facts about Sarah Hale.














































