There are 5 activities to go with this book as well as a storyboard to use for group discussions.

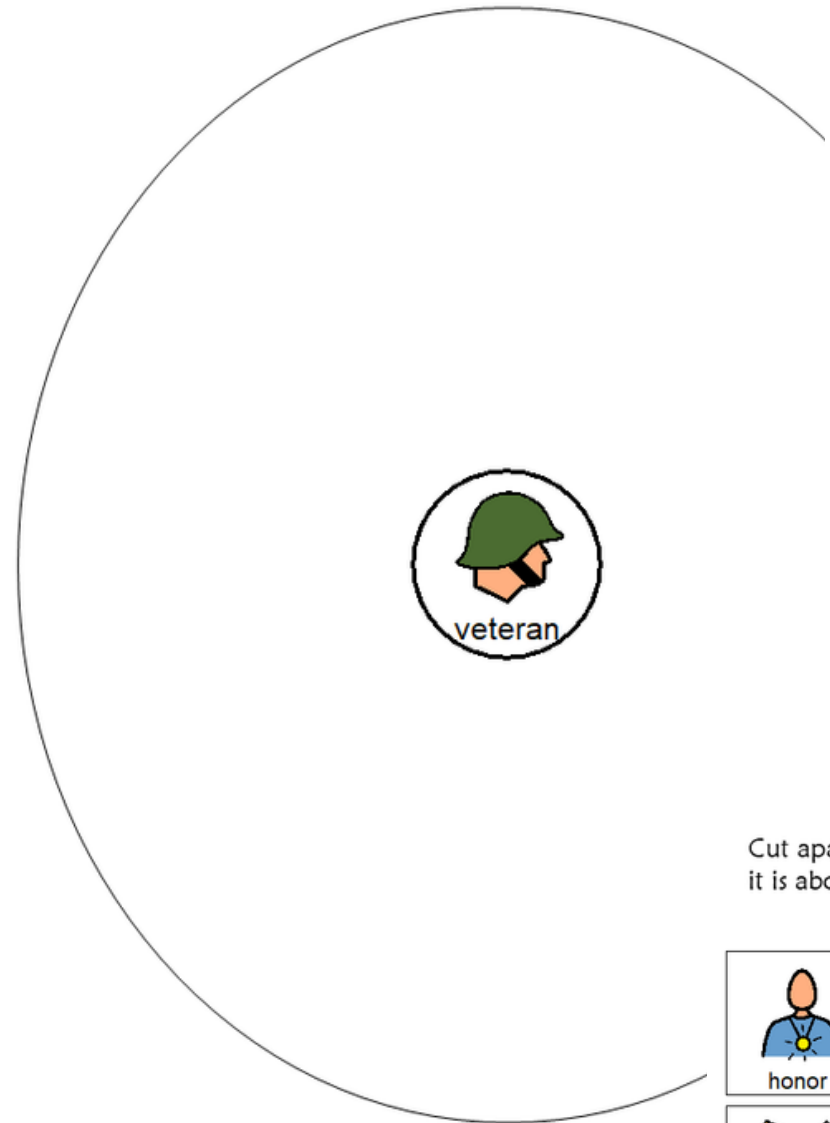

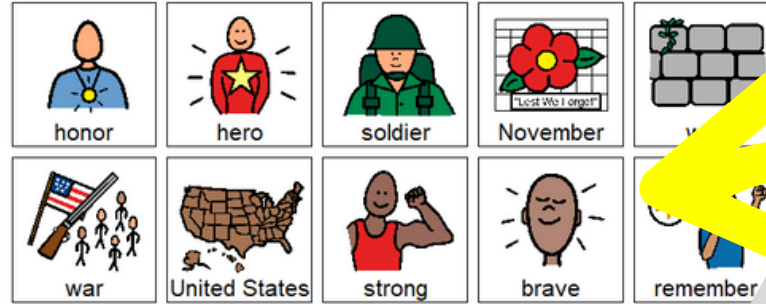

Cut apart pictures and place in circle map **ONLY IF** you think it is about veterans.

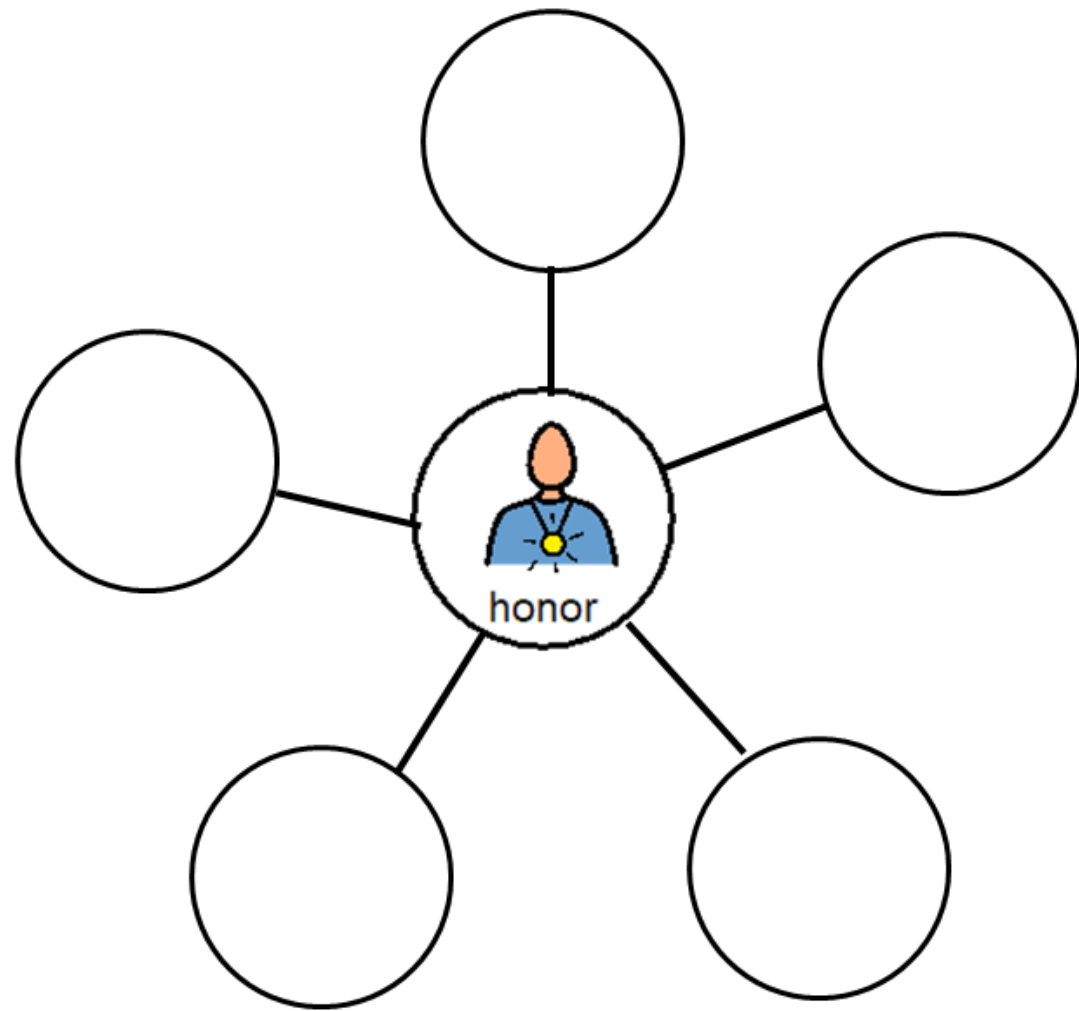


There is a circle map. It comes with 2 choices:

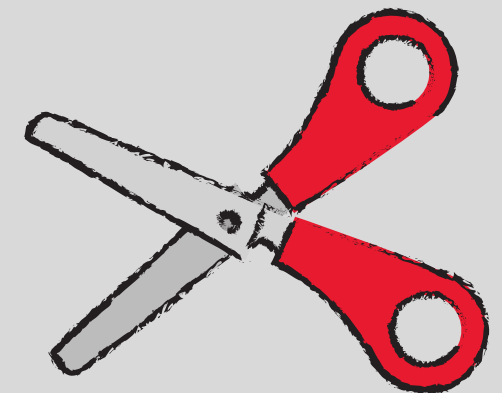
An errorless option with only correct answers

What does honor mean?



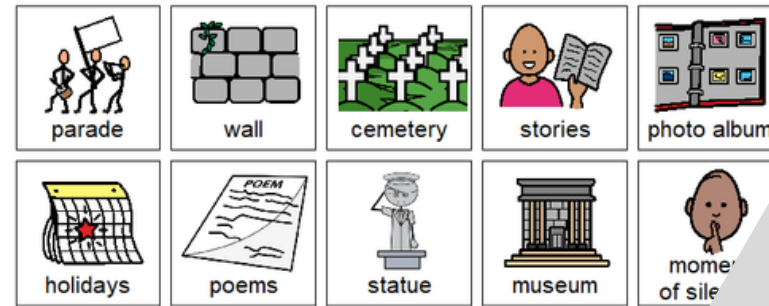
There is a thinking map looking at what the word honor means.

Cut apart pictures and place in circle map about showing ways we can honor and remember heroes.

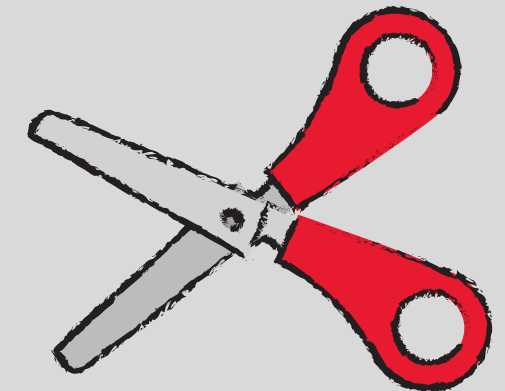


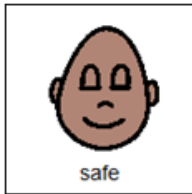
