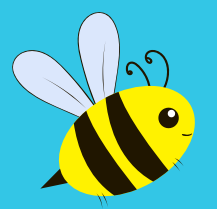

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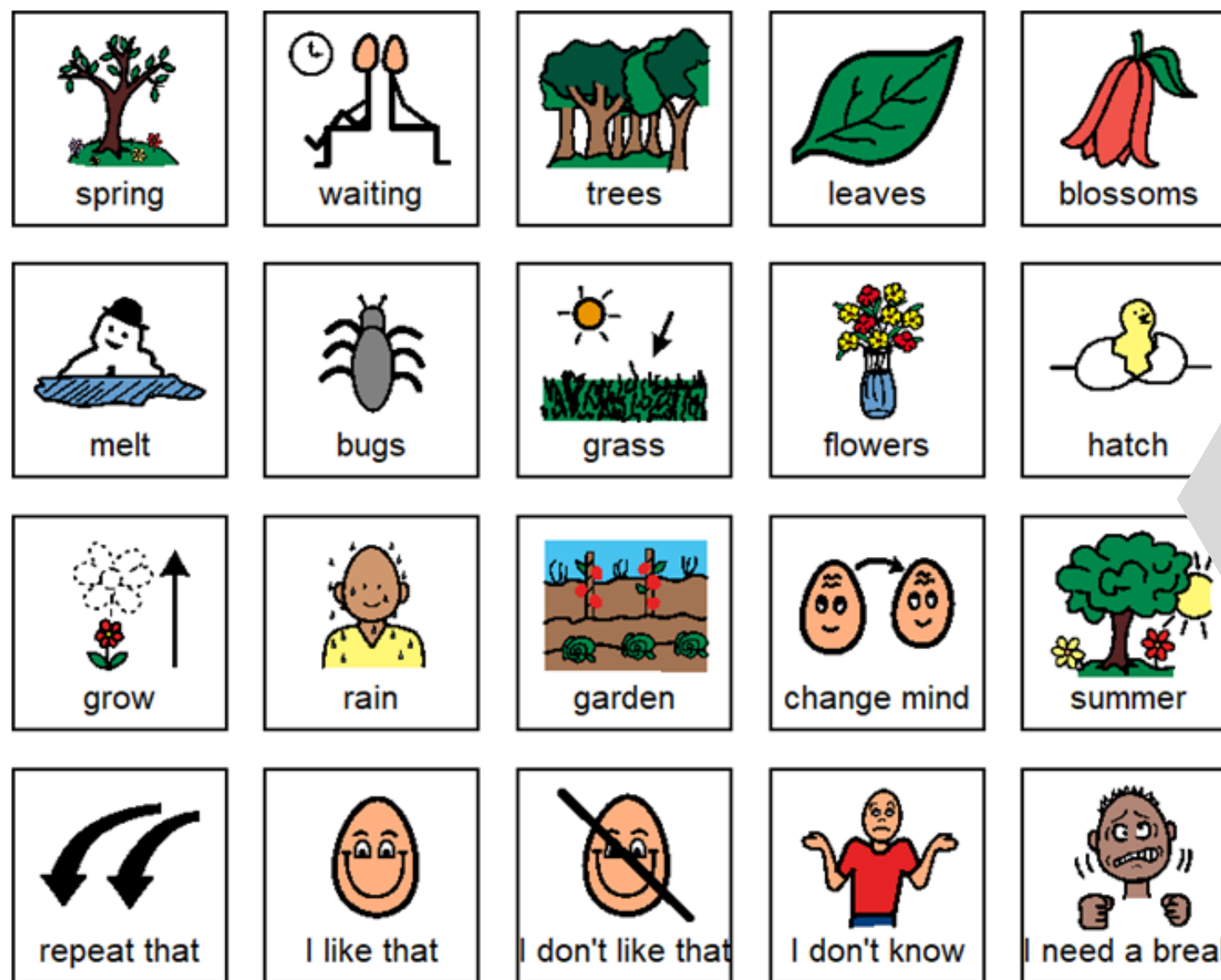

This unit comes with a storyboard.

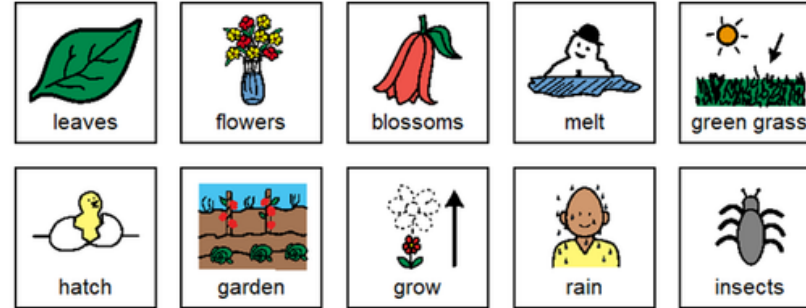
Storyboards are great for ALL students to assist with participation and engagement in group discussions.

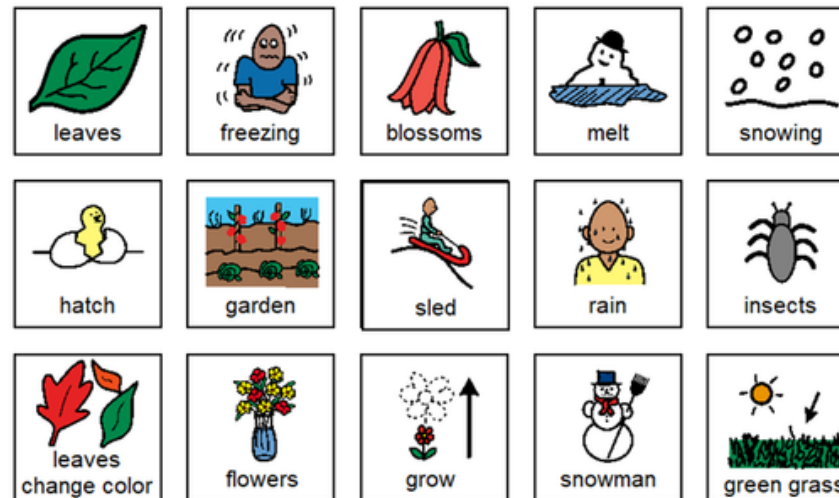
What are some signs of spring?

Place some things in the circle map that signs of spring.

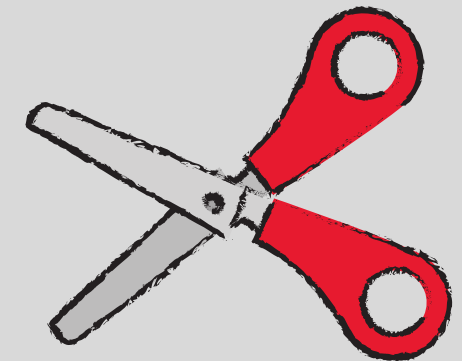


Place the following on the previous page **ONLY IF** they are signs of spring.

There is a circle map showing signs spring is coming. There is an option that only has correct answers and one that has wrong answers mixed in.



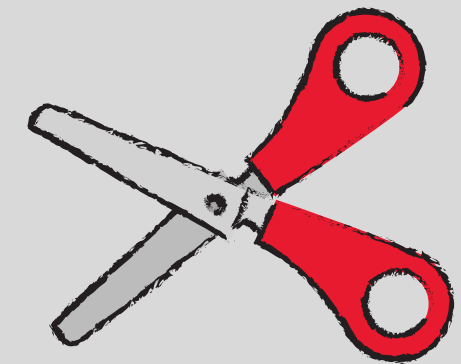

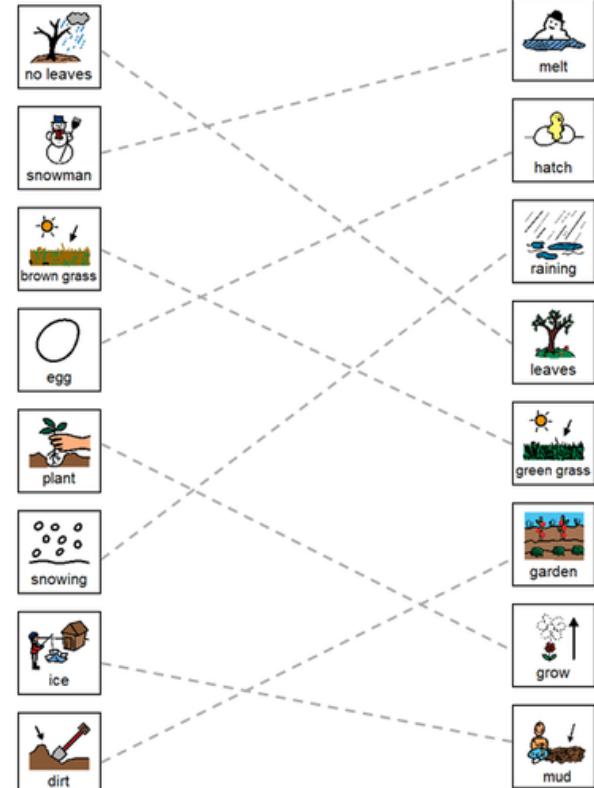

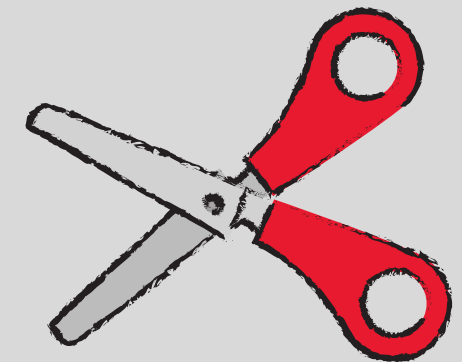
Draw a line to what happens once spring comes.

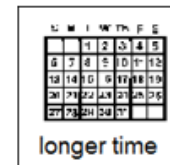

Waiting for spring can feel like it might take forever. Some things take a short time, and some take a longer time.

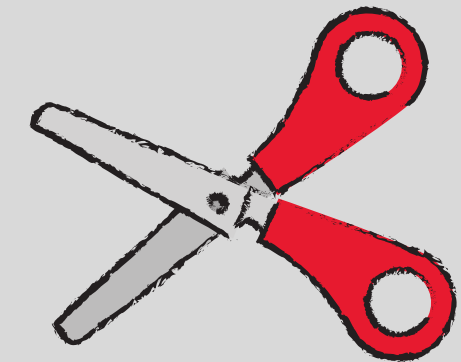


Sorting activity cards:

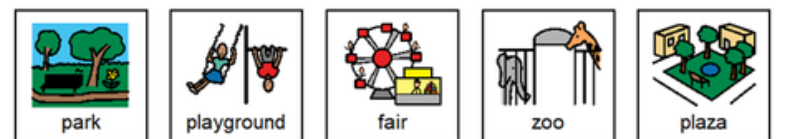
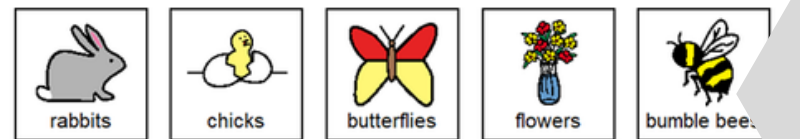

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Students will write a story about waiting for spring. This is an errorless activity that allows students to write their own story independently.

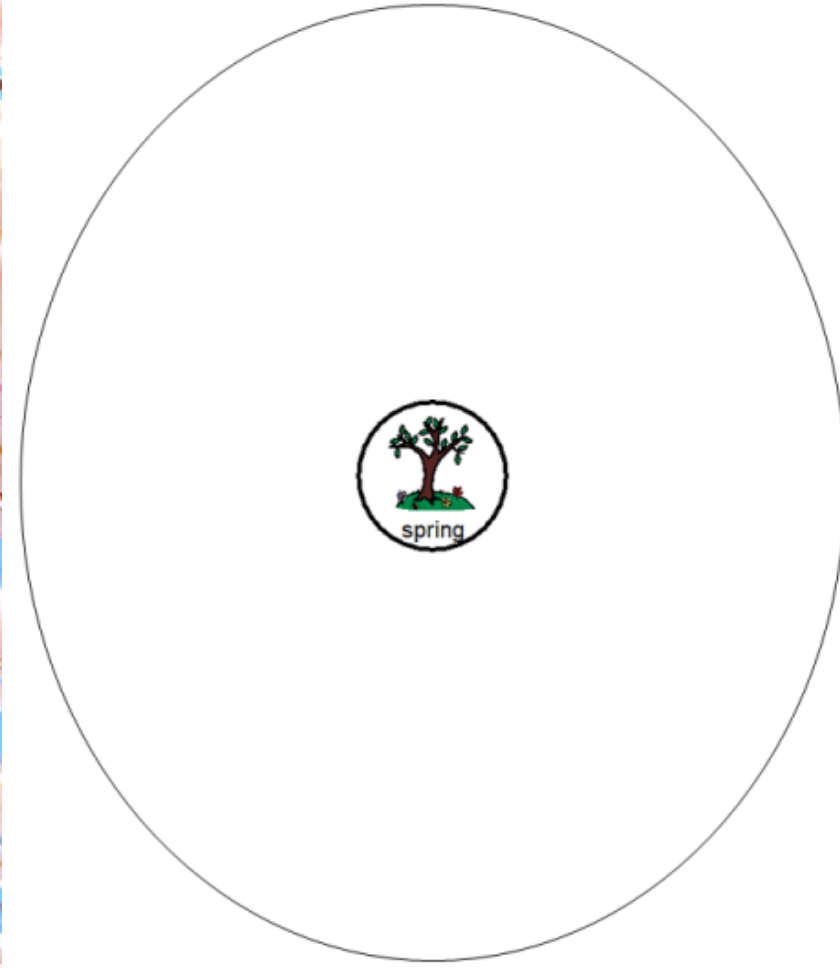

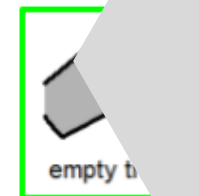
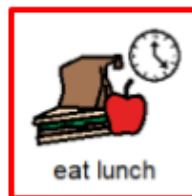
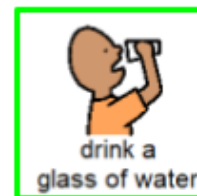
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There are digital versions of the activities included. Students click and drag the answers.






Sort things that take a short time and things that take a longer time.
